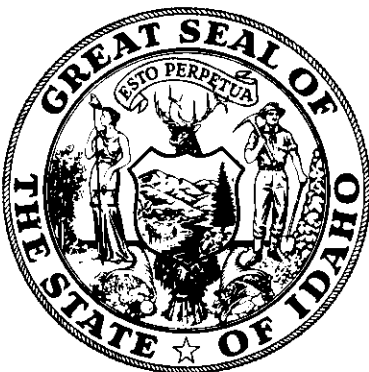

1 ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF  
2 IDAHO STATE ASSOCIATION OF PRIVATE INVESTIGATORS  
3 AND SECURITY COMPANIES, INC.

5 The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a  
6 non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho,  
7 hereby adopt the following:

8 ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

9 I.

10 The name of the corporation is IDAHO STATE  
11 ASSOCIATION OF PRIVATE INVESTIGATORS AND SECURITY COMPANIES,  
12 INC.

13 II.

14 This corporation shall be a non-profit corporation.

15 III.

16 The period of duration of this non-profit corporation  
17 shall be perpetual.

18 IV.

19 The general nature of the business of this  
20 corporation is:

21 a. To foster and encourage development and  
22 implementation of professional standards of conduct of  
23 individuals engaging in the conduct of private investigations  
24 and the operation of security companies; to promote the  
25 enactment of reasonable legislation regulating the conduct and  
26 licensure of private investigators and security companies by  
27 the State of Idaho; to promote, enhance, and regulate the

1 conduct and performance of the members of this association in  
2 order to eliminate unscrupulous operators and to protect the  
3 public; to promote the interest of its members and act for  
4 their mutual protection.

5 b. To promote efficiency in the conduct of the  
6 businesses and to eliminate unwise and unfair business  
7 practices.

8 c. To protect is members against unfair taxes and  
9 legislative enactments.

10 d. To advise and assist the members in the conduct  
11 of their own businesses and to promote standards of ethical  
12 business practices.

13 e. To do any and all things necessary or incident  
14 thereto.

15 V.

16 Membership

17 a. ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP. Membership in the association  
18 shall be limited to persons actively engaged in the business of  
19 a private investigator or security company and have met the  
20 qualifications established by the Board of Directors of this  
21 corporation and adopted in the Bylaws.

22 b. VOTING. Each active member shall be entitled to  
23 one (1) vote in the election of the directors of the  
24 association. Proxy voting is permitted.

25 c. EXPULSION. Any member ceasing to have the  
26 necessary qualifications as set forth in these articles or who  
27 ceases to abide by the rules and regulations adopted by the

1 association may be dropped from the rolls of membership by the  
2 Board of Directors as provided for in the Bylaws.

3 d. ASSOCIATE MEMBERS. Additional categories of  
4 non-voting memberships may be established by the Bylaws of the  
5 corporation.

6 VI.

7 The annual dues required for membership in the  
8 association shall be determined as set forth in the Bylaws of  
9 the corporation. The amount of dues may be changed from year  
10 to year, but such amount shall be the same for all active  
11 members. Any change in the amount of dues shall be as set  
12 forth in the Bylaws.

13 VII.

14 The location of the registered office of this  
15 corporation in the State of Idaho is at 1001 Spokane Street,  
16 Post Falls, Idaho 83854. The name of the registered agent of  
17 the corporation at that address is Judd & Judd, P.A., whose  
18 mailing address is P.O. Box 999, Post Falls, Idaho 83854.

19 VIII.

20 The name and address of each of the initial Board of

22 meeting of the membership or until their successors are duly

Distribution of Property on Dissolution

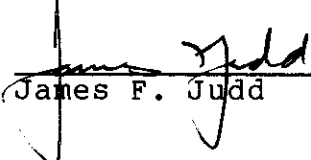

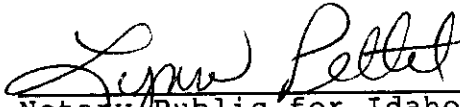
