ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the undersigned, being a natural citizen of full age and a citizen of the United States of America, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, under and pursuant to the provisions of the general laws of the State of Idaho, does hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation shall be J. M. MILLER ENTERPRISES, INC.

ARTICLE II

The Corporation's purposes are:

1. To purchase, or in any way acquire for investment or for sale or otherwise, lands, contracts for the purchase or sale of lands, buildings, improvements, and any other real property of any kind or any interest therein, and as the consideration for same to pay cash or to issue the capital stock, debenture bonds, mortgage bonds, or other obligations of the corporation, and to sell, convey, lease, mortgage, deed of trust, turn to account, or otherwise deal with all or any part of the property of the corporation; to make and obtain loans upon real estate, improved

or unimproved, and upon personal property, giving or taking evidences of indebtedness and securing the payment thereof by mortgage, trust deed, pledge or otherwise; and to enter into contracts to buy or sell any property, real or personal; to buy and mortgages, trust deeds, contracts, and evidences of sell indebtedness; to purchase or otherwise acquire, for the purpose of holding or disposing of the same, real or personal property of every kind and description, including the good will, stock, rights, and property of any person, firm, association, or corporation, paying for the same in cash, stock, or bonds of this corporation; and to draw, make, accept, endorse, discount, execute, and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange, warrants, bonds, debentures, and other negotiable or transferable instruments, or obligations of the corporation, from time to time, for any of the objects or purposes of the corporation without restriction or limit as to amount.

2. To purchase, to receive by way of gift, subscribe for, invest in, and in all other ways acquire, import, lease, possess, maintain, handle on consignment, own, hold for investment or otherwise use, enjoy, exercise, operate, manage, conduct, perform, make, borrow, guarantee, contract in respect of, trade and deal in, sell, exchange, let, lend, export, mortgage, pledge, deed of trust, hypothecate, encumber, transfer, assign and in all other ways dispose of, design, develop invent, improve, equip, repair, alter,

fabricate, assemble, build, construct, operate, manufacture, plant, cultivate, produce, market, and in all other ways (whether like or unlike any of the foregoing), deal in and with property of every kind and character, real, personal or mixed, tangible or intangible, wherever situated and however held, including, but not limited to, money, credits, choses in action, securities, stocks, bonds, warrants, script, certificates, debentures, mortgages, notes, commercial paper and other obligations and evidences of interest in or indebtedness of any person, firm or corporation, foreign or domestic, or of any government or subdivision or agency thereof, documents of title, and accompanying rights, and every other kind and character of personal property, real property (improved or unimproved), and the products and avails thereof, and every character of interest therein and appurtenance thereto, including, but not limited to, mineral, oil, gas and water right., all or any part of any going business and its incidents, franchises, subsidies, charters, concessions, grants, rights, powers or privileges, granted or conferred by any government or subdivision or agency thereof, and any interest in or part of any of the foregoing, and to exercise in respect thereof all of the rights, powers, privileges, and immunities of individual owners or holders thereof.

3. To hire and employ agents, servants and employees, and to enter into agreements of employment and collective

bargaining agreements of employment and collective bargaining agreements, and to act as agent, contractor, trustee, factor or otherwise, either alone or in company with others.

- 4. To promote or aid in any manner, financially or otherwise, any person, firm, association or corporation, and to guarantee contracts and other obligations.
- 5. To carry on any business whatsoever that this corporation may deem proper or convenient in connection with any of the foregoing purposes or otherwise, or that it may deem calculated, directly or indirectly, to improve the interests of this corporation, and to have and to exercise all powers conferred by the laws of the State of Idaho on corporations formed under the laws pursuant to which and under which this corporation is formed, as such laws are now in effect or may at any time hereafter be amended, and to do any and all things hereinabove set forth to the same extent and as fully as natural persons might or could do, either alone or in connection with other persons, firms, associations or corporations, and in any part of the world.
- 6. The foregoing statement of purposes shall be construed as a statement of both purposes and powers, shall be liberally construed in aid of the powers of this corporation, and the powers and purposes stated in each clause shall, except where otherwise stated, be in nowise limited or restricted by any term or provision of any other clause, and shall be regarded not only

as independent purposes, but the purposes and powers stated shall be construed distributively as each object expressed, and the enumeration as to specific powers shall not be construed as to limit in any manner the aforesaid general powers, but are in furtherance of, and in addition to and not in limitation of said general powers.

ARTICLE III

The Corporation is to have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IV

The location and post office address of the Corporation's registered office in this state shall be: 1461 Cottonwood (Box 700), Sun Valley, ID 83353. That James M. Miller shall be the registered agent, whose address is 1461 Cottonwood (Box 700), Sun Valley, ID 83353.

ARTICLE V

The total number of shares which the Corporation is authorized to issue is 1000 shares. Said stock shall be no par value stock.

The power to appeal and amend the By-Laws and adopt new By-Laws is hereby conferred upon the Directors, as well as on the shareholders, to be exercised by such vote of the Directors or of the allotted shares, as the case may be; provided, however, not less than a majority thereof as may be fixed by the By-Laws.

ARTICLE IX

The authorized and treasury stock of this corporation may be issued at such time, upon such terms and conditions and for such consideration that the Board of Directors shall determine.

ARTICLE X

No contract or other transaction between the corporation or any other corporation, whether or not a majority of the shares of the capitol stock of such corporation is owned by the corporation, and no act of the corporation shall in any way be affected or invalidated by the fact that any of the Directors of the corporation are pecuniarily or otherwise interested in, or are directors or officers of such other corporation; any Director individually may be a party to or may be pecuniarily or otherwise interested in any contract or transaction of the corporation and any Director of the corporation who is so interested may be counted in determining the existence of a quorum at any meeting of the Board of Directors or the company which shall authorize such contract or transaction and may vote thereon to authorize such contract or transaction with like force and effect as if he were not such Director or office of such other corporation and not so interested.
