Pursuant to Title 30, Chapter 3, Idaho Code, the undersigned non-profit corporation amends its articles of incorporation as follows:

- 1. The name of this corporation is Powerhouse Christian Fellowship, Inc.
- 2. The text of each amendment is as follows:

Article 2:

Purpose.

The specific purpose for which the corporation is initially organized is to establish and oversee places of worship, conduct the work of evangelism, create departments necessary to support missionary activities and to license and ordain ministers of the gospel and to also engage in activities which are necessary, suitable or convenient for the accomplishment of that purpose, or which are incidental thereto or connected therewith which are consistent with Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for religious purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3), Internal Revenue Code.

Article 8:

Dissolution.

In the event that this corporation ceases to function as an Assemblies of God church or is dissolved for any reason, its assets shall be distributed to the Southern Idaho Ministry Network of the Assemblies of God, provided it qualifies at such time for exemption as an organization described in 501c (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, or a successor statute. In the event that the Southern Idaho Ministry Network does not so qualify, then the assets of the corporation shall be to the General Council of the Assemblies of God, Springfield Missouri, provided it qualifies at such time for exemption as an organization described in Section 501c (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, or a successor statute. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction in the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Non-Profit Organization

No part of the net earning of the corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the

corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article #. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation will not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by (i) a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law, or (ii) a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 c (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or any other corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

Each amendment consists exclusively of matter which do not require member approval pursuant to section 30-3-90, Idaho code, and was, therefore, adopted by the board of directors.
