ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
LEMHI SENIOR BOYS BASEBALL ASSOCIATION, INC.

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SEC. OF STATE
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The undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of the State of Idaho do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation shall be LEMHI SENIOR BOYS BASEBALL ASSOCIATION, INC. The existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE II.

This corporation shall be a Non-Profit Corporation.

ARTICLE III.

This corporation is organized for educational and athletic purposes, specifically for the organization and operation of a youth baseball league.

ARTICLE IV.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and

distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

ARTICLE V.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated

exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE VI.

The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of the corporation is five, and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first annual meeting of the members or until their successors are elected and shall qualify are:

Successor directors shall be elected by the existing Board of Directors pursuant to Idaho Code Section 30-314(f).

ARTICLE VII.
