ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
LOST RIVER BOWL, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the undersigned, J. Robert Tullis, John C. Hepworth, Robert F. Barter, Myron Thompson and H. E. Hammerquist, all residents of the State of Idaho, and citizens of the United States of America, of the age of majority, do hereby associate themselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and to that end, do hereby adopt and execute the following Articles of Incorporation, and do hereby certify and declare:

I.

That the name of said corporation is, and shall be, LOST RIVER BOWL, INC.

II.

That said corporation is formed for the following purposes:

- a. To operate a bowling alley, snack bar, restaurant, lounge and other activities in connection with the operation of facilities necessary for such activities.
- b. To promote, engage in or operate, dance halls, lounges, cafes, and other things or places which have as their object the providing of entertainment at a profit for said corporation.
- c. To own, operate, or maintain hotels, motels, and generally to buy and sell real estate; own, operate and manage farms.
- d. To receive, acquire, hold, purchase, dispose of,

convey, mortgage and/or lease, real and personal property; dispose of, sell, lease, assign, transfer, mortgage and/or convey any rights, privileges, franchises, real or personal property of the corporation, other than its franchise of being a corporation, and to acquire, purchase, guarantee, hold, mortgage, own, vote, sell, pledge and/or otherwise dispose of and deal in shares, bonds, securities and debentures and other evidences of indebtedness of its own and other corporations, domestic or foreign.

- e. To conduct business in this state, other states, District of Columbia, territories and colonies of the United States and in foreign countries, and to have one or more offices and places of business out of this state, and to acquire, receive, hold, purchase, lease, mortgage, dispose of and/or convey any personal property situate both in and out of this state.
- f. To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind and for any lawful purpose, without limit as to amount, with any person, firm, association, corporation, or municipality, state or government, or any sub-division, district or department thereof.
- g. To do any and all other such acts, things, business or businesses in any manner connected with or necessary, incidental, convenient or auxiliary to any of the objects hereinbefore enumerated, or calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the interest of the corporation; and in carrying out its purposes, or for the purpose of maintaining

or furthering any of its business.

- h. The several clauses contained in this statement of purposes shall be construed as both purposes and powers, and the statements contained in each clause shall be in no ways limited or restricted, by reference to, or inference from, the terms of any other clause, but shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers; and no recitation, expression, or declaration of specific or special powers or purposes herein enumerated shall be deemed to be exclusive; but it is hereby expressly declared that all other lawful powers not inconsistent herewith are hereby included.

III.

That the location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation shall be Arco, Butte County, State of Idaho.

IV.

That, subject to dissolution in the manner provided by law, the duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

V.

That the amount of the authorized stock of said corporation shall be Fifty Thousand Dollars, divided into five thousand (5000) shares of common stock at the par value of ten dollars (\$10.00) each.

VI.
