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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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OF

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EIMERS PARK, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, D. J. SOLTMAN and MARY FRAN SOLTMAN, both of whom are citizens of the United States, associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit, social and benevolent corporation under the provisions of Chapter III, Title 30, Idaho Code, amendatory and supplemental thereto, and we do certify and declare as follows:

ARTICLE I.

That the name of the corporation shall be EIMERS PARK, INC.

ARTICLE II.

The objectives of this corporation are:

- 1. To provide for improvement and maintenance of Eimers Park and provide for tax deductible donations for the park.
- 2. To render constructive civic service for the promotion of the welfare of the community and of the citizens of Grangeville, Idaho, and Idaho County; to inculcate civic consciousness by means of active participation in constructive projects, including Eimers Park, which will improve the community, state and nation.
- 3. To engage in any and all types of activities not prohibited by law which shall promote and foster better citizenship in the community and which shall promote educational, recreational, physical and social activities of the community; to promote and foster mutual understanding and good will among all

1 persons, to engage in such activities as shall raise the standards  
2 of civic morality and community welfare through educational,  
3 recreational and social facilities, and to disseminate such  
4 knowledge as shall be useful for all citizens in their work and  
5 home life and so shall make them more proficient in their  
6 activities as citizens and residents of this city, county and  
7 state.

8 4. To aid in the promotion of Chambers of Commerce and other  
9 similar civic organizations of the community; to cooperate with the  
10 officials of political subdivisions of the state and federal  
11 agencies, and all municipal organizations, in the formation of  
12 plans and specifications for projects such as Eimers Park and aid  
13 in the attainment of said purposes and objectives.

14 5. To receive, acquire, hold, purchase, dispose of, convey,  
15 mortgage and/or lease, real and personal property; to dispose of,  
16 sell, lease, assign, transfer, mortgage and/or convey any rights,  
17 privileges, franchises, real or personal property of the  
18 corporation, other than its franchise of being a corporation; and  
19 to acquire, purchase, guaranty, hold, mortgage, own vote, sell,  
20 pledge and/or otherwise dispose of and deal in shares, bonds,  
21 securities and debentures and other evidence of indebtedness or  
22 other corporations, domestic or foreign.

23 **ARTICLE III.**

24 The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

25 **ARTICLE IV.**

26 That the principal place of business of this corporation shall  
27 be at 1102 South B, Grangeville, Idaho 83530.  
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**ARTICLE V.**

That the fiscal year of this corporation shall be from the date of its inception to the conclusion of that year and thereafter annually from January 1 to December 31.

**ARTICLE VI.**

Membership, qualifications and payment of dues, if any, shall be determined by, and in the discretion of the said Board of Directors of this Corporation, subject, however, to the provisions of these articles.

**ARTICLE VII.**

No member shall be liable for, nor shall any of their property be subject to, any debt or obligation of the corporation.

**ARTICLE VIII.**

The corporation shall have no capital stock, and the rights and interests of such members shall be equal with no one having the right to acquire greater interest of the others.

**ARTICLE IX.**

Upon dissolution of this corporation, after payment of all debts, obligations and liabilities of the corporation or the making of adequate provision therefore, the remaining property and assets shall be distributed back to the trust originally granting the money and the property for the development of this organization or, in the alternative, at the discretion of the Board of Directors, to be used for the benevolent purposes as set forth in these articles.

**ARTICLE X.**

That the directors of this corporation shall be such number of persons, not less than three (3), nor more than ten (10), as may

1 be, from time to time, prescribed by the by-laws, and until the  
2 first meeting and organization of the corporation, the following  
3 persons shall serve as directors of said corporation, to-wit:
