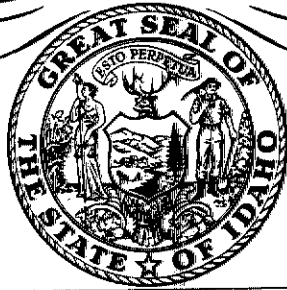

1 ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

2 OF

3 BOB COOK, INC.

5 KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned,
6 being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States
7 of America, in order to form a corporation for the purposes herein-
8 after stated pursuant to the Business Corporation Act of the State
9 of Idaho, do hereby certify as follows:

10 I.

11 The name of this corporation is: BOB COOK, INC.

12 II.

13 The purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

14 (a) To buy and sell on commission or otherwise, at whole-
15 sale or retail, fruit, vegetables, and all kinds of farm produce,
and to transact all business incidental or appurtenant thereto.

16 (b) To engage in the business of buying, selling, dis-
17 tributing, leasing, servicing, repairing, and otherwise dealing in
agricultural implements, vehicles, materials, machinery, equipment
18 and supplies, and in implements, vehicles, materials, machinery,
equipment and supplies of allied lines.

19 (c) To acquire, own or operate any type of mercantile
20 establishment; and to purchase, sell, barter, exchange and generally
deal in all types of goods, wares and merchandise.

21 (d) To purchase, own, hold, lease (either as lessor or
22 as lessee), exchange, subdivide, mortgage, sell and generally operate
and deal in any and all types of real property within or without the
23 State of Idaho, necessary, suitable or useful in connection with the
operation of the business of this corporation.

24 (e) To acquire, own, hold, construct, erect, lease (either
25 as lessor or as lessee) mortgage, pledge, sell and generally operate
and deal in any and all types of machinery, equipment and personal
26 property.

27 (f) To purchase, hold, sell and transfer the shares of
its own capital stock; provided it shall not use its funds or pro-
28 perty for the purchase of its own shares of capital stock when such
use would cause any impairment of its capital; and provided further
29 that the shares of its own capital stock owned by it shall not be
voted upon directly or indirectly.

30 (g) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts
31 of every sort and kind which may be necessary or desirable for the
furtherance of the business of this corporation, with any person
32 or persons, firms, corporations, associations, any state, territory
or municipality of the United States or any foreign country, govern-
ment or body politic.

1 (h) To purchase, acquire, and hold all or any part of
2 the property, capital stock, assets or good will of any business,
3 of any person, firm, association or corporation engaged in any
4 business in whole or in part similar to that of this corporation,
5 consistent with the objects and purposes of this corporation, and
6 to hold, utilize and in any manner dispose of the whole or any part
7 of the stock, assets, property, good will and rights so acquired and
8 to conduct in any lawful manner in whole or in part any business so
9 acquired, and to undertake or assume the whole or any part of the
10 obligations or liabilities of any person, firm, association or cor-
11 poration engaged in the business so acquired.

12 (i) To adopt, apply for and register, purchase, lease or
13 otherwise acquire and to use, maintain and protect and to sell,
14 assign or grant licenses or other rights in respect of any trade
15 marks, trade names, patents, patent rights, copyrights, inventions,
16 formulas, processes and rights analogous thereto.

17 (j) To borrow money for any purpose of this corporation
18 without limit as to amount, and to issue bonds, debentures, notes
19 and other evidences of indebtedness, secured or unsecured, of this
20 corporation for the moneys so borrowed, or in payment for property
21 acquired, or for any other objects or purposes of this corporation
22 or in connection with its business; to secure payment of such
23 debentures, notes or other obligations by mortgages, or deeds of
24 trust or pledges or other liens upon any or all of the property of
25 this corporation wheresoever situated.

26 (k) To carry out all or any part of the foregoing objects
27 or purposes as principal or agent, or otherwise, either alone or
28 in conjunction with any person, association or other corporation
29 and in any part of the world; and in carrying on its business and
30 for the purpose of attaining or furthering any of its objects or
31 purposes, to make and perform such contracts of any kind and descrip-
32 tion, to do such acts and such things, and to exercise any and all
such powers as a natural person could lawfully make, perform, do or
exercise, provided that the same be not inconsistent with the objects
or purposes of this corporation, or the statutes of the State of
Idaho.

1 (l) To conduct its business in all or any of its branches
2 in the State of Idaho and in any and all other states, territories,
3 possession, colonies and dependencies of the United States of
4 America and in the District of Columbia, and in any and all foreign
5 countries and to have one or more offices within or outside the
6 State of Idaho.

7 (m) The objects as specified herein shall, except as other-
8 wise expressed, be in no way limited or restricted by reference to
9 or inference from the terms of any other clause or paragraph of these
10 Articles. The objects, purposes and powers specified in each of the
11 clauses or paragraphs in these Articles shall be regarded as inde-
12 pendent objects, purposes and powers.

13 III.

14 The principal office and place of business of this corpora-
15 tion shall be Route #1, Wilder, in the County of Canyon, State of
16 Idaho.

17 IV.

18 The period of existence and the duration of the life of

1 this corporation shall be perpetual.

2 V.

3 This corporation is authorized to issue one class of shares
4 of its capital stock to be designated as common stock; the total
5 number of shares of common stock which this corporation shall be
6 authorized to issue is 100. The aggregate par value of the capital
7 stock of this corporation shall be \$10,000.00; and the par value of
8 each of said shares of common stock shall be \$100.00.

9 VI.

10 The names and post office addresses of each of the incorpor-
11 ators of this corporation and the number of shares of said common
12 capital stock subscribed by each of those incorporators, are as

22 a natural person over the age of 21 years and is a citizen of the

24 VII.

25 The capital stock of this corporation shall be non-assess-
26 able; and the private property of the shareholders in this corporation
27 shall not be liable for the debts, obligations and liabilities of
28 this corporation.

29 VIII.

30 A director of this corporation shall not be required to
31 be a holder of any of the shares of the common capital stock of the
32 corporation.


