ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, David G. Hagele, Jim W. Griffith, and Danny L. Turner, each being a natural person of full age, and a citizen of the United States of America, have voluntarily and do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, and we do hereby certify, declare and adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

I.

The name of the corporation shall be D & J ELECTRONICS, INC.

II.

The period of existence and duration of the life of this corporation shall be perpetual.

III.

The location of the registered office of this corporation shall be Grangeville, Idaho County, State of Idaho, and the address of the registered office of the corporation shall be Route 2, Box 13, Grangeville, Idaho 83530 and the registered agent at this address is Danny L. Turner.

IV.

The nature of the business and the objectives and purposes to be transacted, promoted and carried out are to do any or all things herein mentioned as fully and to the same extent as natural persons might or could do, and in any part of the world, viz:

To carry on and conduct the manufacturing, transportation, merchandizing and servicing of electronic equipment and products, and to transact any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

V.

The Capital Stock of this corporation shall be TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000.00) divided into two thousand, five hundred (2,500) shares of stock at a par value of TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) each. No distinction shall exist between the shares of this corporation and all shares shall have the same right in the corporation.
