ARTICLE V <u>Preemptive Rights</u>

This Corporation elects to have preemptive rights.

ARTICLE VI <u>Cumulative Voting</u>

In all elections for Directors, shareholders shall <u>not</u> be permitted to cumulate their votes. Shareholders shall be limited to one vote for each share of stock registered in the shareholder's name on the books of the Corporation.

ARTICLE X Elimination of Personal Liability of Directors

The directors of this Corporation are not liable to the corporation or to its shareholders for monetary damages arising from a breach of fiduciary duty or for any action taken or any failure to take any action as a director, except:

- (3) for any transaction from which the director derived an improper personal benefit.

ARTICLE XI Indemnification of Directors & Officers

The Corporation shall have the authority, in accordance with Idaho State law, to indemnify each director or officer, or any person who may have served at its request as a director or officer of another corporation in which it has shares of capital stock or of which it is a creditor, against expenses actually and necessarily incurred by him or her in connection with the defense of any action, suit, or proceeding in which he or she is made a party by reason of being or having been a director or officer of the Corporation or of such other corporation (whether or not her or she continues to be a director or officer at the time of incurring such expense) except in relation to matters as to which he or she shall be adjudged in such action, suit, or proceeding to be liable for negligence or willful misconduct in the performance of his duty as such director or officer. Such indemnification shall not be deemed exclusive of any other rights to which those indemnified may be entitled under any Bylaw, agreement, vote of shareholders, or otherwise.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION - 3.

The Corporation shall have the right to defend and to incur reasonable expenses in the defense of any such actions, suits, or proceedings brought against any such director, officer, or person. Wherever in this section a director or officer is referred to, such reference shall include his or her personal representatives, executors, and administrators.
