ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE 1 NAME

The name of the corporation is IDAHO BASIC TRAUMA
LIFE SUPPORT, INC.

ARTICLE II PURPOSES

The specific and primary purpose for which this
corporation is formed are to engage exclusively in
nonprofit, charitable and scientific activities and
more particularly to:

(a) Assist and cooperate with medical, scientific,
legal and nonprofit organizations interested in trauma
care and prevention in Idaho.

(b) Educate and train such persons as physicians,
hospital personnel, prehospital care providers, police
and public health officers.

(c) Encourage and foster research and the education
and training of persons in order to qualify them to
engage in medical and scientific research in that
field, the results to be made available to medical
personnel engaged in the medical and surgical
treatment of injuries.

(d) Encourage and foster the development of community
programs to prevent injuries, to improve the care of
the injured, and to minimize the disability resulting
therefrom.

(e) Cause to be established, as from time to time may
be deemed desirable, associated or affiliated
organizations to be designated as have substantially
the same purposes as the corporation: and, by
agreements with the hereby names "Units" to assist
them in carrying out those purposes in defined
geographical areas within Idaho to renew, continue, or
terminate such agreements.

f) Solicit and accept contributions of money and
property, including but without limiting the
generality of the foregoing, grants from foundations
and Federal or other governmental sources, and to
accept devices, bequest and gifts of all property

whether received through trusts, endowments, deeds of gifts, annuities, policies of insurance or otherwise, and to use and administer such property for furtherance of these corporate purposes.

The general purposes and powers of the corporation are to have and exercise all rights and powers conferred on nonprofit corporations under the laws of the State of Idaho necessary or incidental to its specific and primary purposes.

ARTICLE III ORGANIZATION

This corporation is organized pursuant to the General Nonprofit Corporation Law of Idaho and does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof and it is organized for nonprofit purposes.

ARTICLE IV REGISTERED OFFICE

The number of directors of this corporation shall be (3) unless and until changed by the adoption of an amendment of these Articles or by an appropriate bylaw.

ARTICLE VI MEMBERSHIP

The authorized number and qualifications of members of this corporation, the different classes of membership, and the voting and other rights and privileges of members shall be set forth in the Bylaws of this corporation. It is the intent of this corporation to have members.

ARTICLE VII EXEMPT STATUS

This corporation is not organized , nor shall it be operated, for pecuniary gain or profit, and it does not contemplate the distribution of gains, profits, or dividends to the members thereof and is organized solely for non-profit purposes. The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to nonprofit, charitable and scientific purposes. On the dissolution or winding up of the corporation its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to and become property of such nonprofit funds, foundations, or corporations as selected and designated by the Board of Directors of the corporation and which have established their tax exempt status under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue code of the United States as it now exists or may subsequently be amended. None of the activities of this corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation, nor shall this corporation participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for political office.
