

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
of the
Sunny Slope Cattle and Land Company, Limited.
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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, having this day voluntarily associated ourselves for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, HEREBY CERTIFY:

ARTICLE I

That the name of said corporation is the SUNNY SLOPE CATTLE AND LAND COMPANY, LIMITED.

ARTICLE II

That the purposes for which it is formed is to engage in and carry on, in Boise County, State of Idaho, and elsewhere, the business of raising, letting, feeding, grazing, buying, selling, and otherwise dealing in cattle, other live stock and poultry; the production, feeding, buying, selling and otherwise dealing in hay, grain, fruit and general farm and dairy products; the killing and dressing of live stock and poultry, and the storing, refrigerating, shipping, buying, selling and otherwise dealing in live stock, poultry, farm and dairy products; to borrow and loan money necessary to the conduct of said business; to acquire, hold and dispose of such real and personal property as the purposes of the corporation may require; and generally, to perform all business and acts essential, necessary or proper to the transaction of its ordinary affairs or for the purposes of the corporation.

ARTICLE III

That the place where its principal business is to be transacted is Boise, Ada County, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE IV

That the term for which it is to exist is fifty years from the date of said incorporation.
