

On April 7, 1987 all voting members and all members of the Board of Directors of the Elmer Keith Museum Foundation, Inc. voted unanimously to change the Articles and By-Laws to allow a museum to be placed in Boise, Idaho coordinated with a rotating exhibit in Salmon, Idaho. Please record the following Articles of Amendment.

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

THIRD: The Corporation is organized for charitable, educational and scientific purposes, within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended (hereinafter the "Code"), and may engage in any lawful act or activity authorized by the State of Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, Idaho Code, Title 30, Chapter 3, in furtherance of such purposes, including, but not limited to the acquiring of a building and the operation and maintenance of a museum in or near the City of Boise, Idaho coordinated with a rotating exhibit in Salmon, Idaho to preserve, protect and maintain the books, articles, trophies, firearms and contributions of Elmer Keith for educational and historical value to the general public. The activities may also include partial support for a public shooting range to be located near Boise, Idaho.
