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## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, have this day associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and to that end do hereby adopt Articles of Incorporation as follows:

ARTICLE I. The name of the proposed corporation is FINANCIAL SECURITY CORPORATION.

ARTICLE II. The purposes of the corporation are as follows:

- (1) To carry on the business of share dealers or financial agents in all transactions relating to the sale, transfer or exchange of every description of stocks, shares, debentures, bonds, mortgages, freehold or leasehold property, life interest, reversions or other securities or investments for money and all transactions and negotiations on commission or otherwise relating to such business; and to advance or negotiate the advance of money at interest on securities or otherwise; and to carry on the business of stock and share brokers, land, estate and mortgage agents and brokers in all branches.
- (2) To transact the business of investing on behalf of itself or others, any part of its capital and such additional funds as it may obtain, or any interest therein, either as tenant in common or otherwise, and selling or otherwise disposing of the same or any part thereof or interest therein.
- (3) To purchase or in any other manner acquire for investment or for sale or otherwise lands, contracts for the purchase or sale of lands, buildings and improvements and any other real property of any kind or nature or interests in real property and as consideration for the same to pay cash or to issue the capital stock, debentures, bonds, mortgages or other obligations of the corporation and to sell, convey, lease, mortgage or otherwise deal with all or any part of the property of the corporation. And to manage, improve, develop and deal in lands and interests in land and to lay out and construct subdivisions, including all types of utilities necessary thereto and to enter into and make contracts and arrangements of all kinds for the construction, management, sale and disposal of said lands, subdivisions and other properties.
- (4) To build, erect, construct, lease or otherwise acquire, manage, occupy, maintain and operate buildings for commercial purposes and for dwelling houses, apartment houses and office buildings and to purchase, acquire, through issuance of its capital stock or otherwise, and to own, hold, lease, either

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as lessor or lessee, and to sell, exchange, subdivide, mortgage, hypothecate and to operate and generally deal in any and all kinds of lands, improved and unimproved, dwelling houses, apartments, hotels, boarding houses, business buildings, manufacturing works and plants and other buildings and structures of any kind.

- To engage in the business of the accumulation and loan of money by lending the capital of the company and such other funds as it may from time to time lawfully acquire from various borrowers, upon such personal security or security of personal or real property as may be agreed upon between the corporation and the borrowers, and by re-lending in like manner the funds arising from such loans when paid; but the corporation shall not have banking or discounting privileges or powers.
- **(6)** To transact the business of a real estate agent or a broker and in behalf of others to buy, sell, deal in, lease, rent and manage real estate and any interest therein.
- To engage in any commercial, industrial or agricultural enterprise calculated or designed to be profitable to this corporation and in conformity with the laws of the State of Idaho;

To engage in, do and perform any enterprise, act or vocation that a natural person might or could do or perform;

To engage in the manufacture, sale, importing and exporting of merchandise and personal property of all manner and description and to act as agents for the purchase, sale and handling of goods, wares and merchandise of any kind and of all types and descriptions for the account of the corporation or as factor or agent or otherwise for and on behalf of another.

ARTICLE III. The duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV. The location and post office address of the corporation shall be P. O. Box 1084, Boise, Idaho. The address of the corporation shall be subject to change by resolution of the Board of Directors at any time.

ARTICLE V. The authorized capital stock of the corporation is the sum of \$25,000.00, represented by 25,000 shares of common, non-assessable stock of a par value of \$1.00 per share.

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ARTICLE VI. The name and post office address of each of the incorporators and the number of shares for which each has subscribed are as follows:

ARTICLE VII. The capital stock of the corporation shall be non-assessable. The corporation shall have the power to purchase its own stock in accordance with the laws of the State of Idaho, as are now in effect or as may hereinafter be enacted.

ARTICLE VIII. The method and manner of holding Directors' meetings and Stockholders' meetings, the authority and duties of each of the officers of the corporation, and all other matters concerning management and control of the corporation shall be determined by the By-Laws of the corporation and by the laws of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE IX. These articles may be amended in any respect conformable to the laws of the State of Idaho by a vote of the required percentage of stockholders as set forth by the statutes and laws of the State of Idaho, at a meeting of stockholders called for that purpose, all as prescribed by law.
