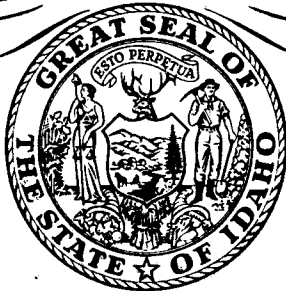

### CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for ~~an~~ **unlimited period** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Boise** in the County of **Ada**

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
RAD Co. of Boise

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of 21 years or more, a majority of whom are residents of the State of Idaho and the United States of America, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves for the purpose of forming a private corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho. We hereby set forth, declare and certify that:

I. The name of this Corporation is RAD Co. of Boise.

II. The purposes of this corporation are:

(1). To transact the business of investing on behalf of itself or others, any part of its capital and such additional funds as it may obtain, or any interest therein, in real property, personal property, mortgages, escrows or any other type of property, real or personal or otherwise, either as tenant in common or otherwise, and selling or otherwise disposing of the same, or any part thereof, or interest therein.

(2). To purchase, acquire, and take over any business as insurance brokers, insurance agents, agents of underwriters and of insurance companies, adjusters of averages, and their kindred business, all as conducted by them in the State of Idaho and in any other places where such acquisition is not forbidden by law.

(3). To transact the business of a real estate agent or broker, and in behalf of others, to buy, sell, deal in, lease, rent, and manage real estate and any interest therein.

(4). To buy, sell, exchange, and generally deal in

real properties, improved and unimproved, and buildings of every class and description; to improve, manage, operate, sell, buy, mortgage, lease, or otherwise acquire or dispose of any property, real or personal, and take mortgages and assignment of mortgages upon the same; to make and obtain loans upon real estate, improved or unimproved, and upon personal property, giving or taking evidences of indebtedness and securing the payment thereof by mortgages, trust deeds, contracts and evidences of indebtedness; to purchase or otherwise acquire, for the purpose of holding or disposing of the same, real or personal property of every kind and description, including the good will, stock, rights, and property of any person, firm association, or corporation, paying for the same in cash, stock, or bonds of this corporation; to draw, make, accept, indorse, discount, execute, and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange, warrants, bonds, debentures, and other negotiable or transferable instruments, or obligations of the corporation, from time to time, for any of the objects or purposes of the corporation; to carry on all or any of its operations without restriction or limit as to amount; to purchase, acquire, hold, own, mortgage, sell, convey, or otherwise dispose of real and personal property of every class and description in any state, district, territory, colony, or foreign country subject to the laws of such state, territory, or foreign country.

(5). To transact the business of investing on behalf of itself or others, any part of its capital and such additional funds as it may obtain or any interest therein, either as tenants in common or otherwise, and selling or otherwise disposing of the same, or any part thereof, or any interest therein;

(6). To appoint such officers, employees and agents

as the business of the corporation may require and to allow them compensation.

(7). To issue shares and admit shareholders, and to engage in all transactions incident to the same.

(8). To purchase the shares of other corporations, or to purchase its own shares.

(9). To make accomodation guaranties, and endorsements, or contracts of suretyship.

(10). To enter into a partnership or joint venture to carryout any of the business purposes for which this corporation is organized.

(11). To engage in any activities or to do anything with the objects and purposes hereinbefore mentioned that may be necessary or proper to accomplish successfully or promote the said objects and purposes. The foregoing clauses, by reason of the specific enumeration of powers shall not be held to restrict the power of the corporation to do any of the things within the purview of its general powers.

III. That the duration of the corporation is unlimited.

IV. The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation in the State of Idaho is 4704 Emerald, Boise, Idaho.

V. The total authorized number of shares is 100 shares with a par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars per share with an aggregate par value of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars.
