ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE IDAHO CHAPTER OF THE AMERICAN PHYSICAL THERAPY ASSOCIATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we the undersigned citizens of the United States of America of full age, and residents of the State of Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated outselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under Title 30, Chapter 10, of the Idaho Code, entitled--"Non-profit Cooperative Associations", AND WE HEREBY CERTIFY:-

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation small be: The Idaho Chapter of the American Physical Therapy Association, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The objectives of this corporation small be:

- 1. To cooperate with the American Physical Therapy Association in its efforts to promote the art and science of medicine through an understanding and utilization of the functions and procedures of physical therapy in the prevention, treatment or alleviation of human ailments and the maintenance of or restoration of health.
- 2. To promote professional interest in and understanding of physical therapy in the area served by the Chapter.
- 3. To cooperate with the medical profession.

ARTICLE III

The period of duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

The location and Post Office Address for this corporation shall be City of Boise, County of Ada, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE V

In this association the rights and interests of all members shall be equal, and no member can have or acquire a greater interest therein than any other member. This association shall not issue any capital stock, but shall issue membership certificates to each member thereof, which certificates cannot be assigned so that the transferee thereof can by such transfer become a member of the association, except by resolution of the Executive Committee and under such regulations as the by-laws may prescribe.

ARTICLE VI

Classes of members of this corporation of the Idaho Chapter of the American Physical Therapy Association, Inc., consist of:

A. Active Members

- 1. Active or Life members in good standing of the American Physical Therapy association who reside or practice within the cerritorial jurisdiction of this chapter.
- 2. Complete such application form or transfer form as may be required and pay annual dues.
- 3. Are entitled to all the rights and privileges of this chapter including the right to vote, to hold office and serve on committees.

B. Affiliated Members

- l. Monorary, Associate, Student and Inactive members in good standing of the American Physical Therapy Association.
- 2. Complete such application form as may be required.
- 3. Are entitled to attend all meetings, and to serve on committees in an advisory capacity, but do not have the right to vote or hold office.
