ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF . KING-PIN, INC.

* * * *

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all of whom are natural persons of full age and are citizens of the United States, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

I

That the name of this corporation shall be

KING-PIN, INC.

II

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

- 1. To build, buy or lease, conduct and operate a bowling alley for the general public; to buy, sell and trade in sporting foods, beverages, candy, chewing gum, popcorn, ice cream, sandwiches, cigars, cigarettes, smoking tobacco, other foods and merchandise.
- 2. To purchase or otherwise acquire, and to hold, own, maintain, work, develop, sell, lease, exchange, hire, convey, mortgage or otherwise dispose of and deal in, lands and leaseholds, and any interests, estate, and rights in real property, and any personal or mixed property, and any franchises, rights, licenses or privileges necessary, convenient or appropriate for any of the purposes herein expressed.
- 3. To borrow money, and to make and issue notes, bonds, debentures, obligations and evidences of indebtedness of all kinds, whether secured by mortgage, pledge or otherwise, without limit as to amount, and to secure the same by mortgage, pledge or otherwise, and generally to make and perform agreements and contracts of every kind and description.
- 4. To carry on any other lawful business whatsoever which may seem to the corporation capable of being carried on in connection with the above, or calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the interest of the corporation or to enhance the valuation of its property.

III

Subject to dissolution in the manner provided by law, the duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

That the principal place of business, registered office and the location and postoffice address of the registered office of said corporation shall be Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, Idaho.

V

The total authorized capital stock of said corporation shall be TEN THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$10,000.00) DOLLARS, divided into One Hundred (100) shares, of the par value of ONE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$100.00) DOLLARS each, and all of said stock shall be common stock.

VI

The number of directors of said corporation shall be not less than three (3) nor more than nine (9), as hereafter fixed and determined by the By-Laws of the corporation.

VII

The Board of Directors shall have the power to repeal and amend the By-Laws of the corporation and adopt new By-Laws at any meeting, of the Board of Directors. All By-Laws shall be subject to amendment, alteration and repeal by the stockholders at any annual meeting or at any special meeting called for such purpose.
