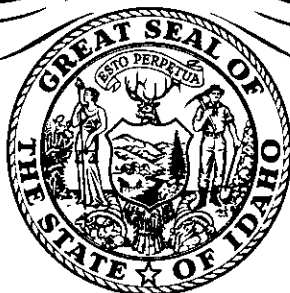

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CRICK CO.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, each being a citizen of the United States and of the State of Washington, James Crick, Jr., Robert Crick and Paul O'Connor, have associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the general laws of the State of Washington, and for that purpose do hereby make and subscribe, in triplicate, the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be Crick Co.

ARTICLE II

The purposes for which this corporation are formed are as follows:

- (a) To engage in the general contracting business and in the employment of labor and equipment for profit and to purchase or otherwise acquire real and personal property and to sell or dispose of the same for profit and generally to render services of all kinds for profit whether related to the above or not.
- (b) To purchase, acquire, lease and hold real property or any interest or estate therein, and to let, convey, mortgage, assign or transfer any such interest as the corporation may deem necessary or convenient in connection with its business. To erect, manage, care for and maintain, extend and alter buildings thereon.
- (c) To acquire, hold, maintain, use and dispose of such furniture, fixtures, equipment, vehicles, tools, machinery, facilities and personal property of all kinds as the corporation may deem necessary or convenient in the operation of its said business.
- (d) To acquire, hold and enjoy, and to sell and dispose of, transfer or assign franchises, licenses, permits and other privileges as may be necessary and convenient in the conduct of the business of the corporation.
- (e) To borrow money, incur indebtedness and issue notes, bonds, debentures or other evidences of debt as may

be deemed necessary; and to mortgage, pledge, hypothecate, convey in trust or otherwise, any or all property of the corporation as security for the payment of any such indebtedness.

- (f) To acquire, hold, mortgage, pledge, sell or otherwise dispose of any stocks, bonds, securities or other obligations of any other corporation, domestic or foreign.
- (g) To contract with persons, associations, corporations or municipalities, or with any state or with the United States or with any corporation owned, controlled or operated by any state of the Union or by the Federal Government or any other body politic.
- (h) To lend money and negotiate loans, with or without security; to draw, accept, endorse, buy and sell promissory notes, bonds, stocks, debentures, coupons and other securities; to issue on commission, subscribe for, take, acquire, hold, sell, exchange and deal in shares, stocks, bonds, obligations and securities of any government authority or company; to form, promote, subsidize and assist companies, syndicates or partnerships of all kinds and to finance and refinance the same.
- (i) To develop and turn to account any land or building acquired by or in which the corporation or anyone is interested, in particular by laying out and preparing the same for building purposes, construction, altering, repairing, pulling down, decorating, maintaining, furnishing, fitting up and improving buildings, and planting, paving, draining, letting or building leases or building agreements, and by advancing money to and entering new contracts and arrangements of all kinds with builders, tenants and others.
- (j) To carry on and undertake any business undertaking, transaction or operation, carried on or undertaken by capitalists, promoters, financiers, concessionaires, contractors, brokers and commission merchants, and any other incidental business which may seem to the company convenient to carry on in connection with the above, or calculated directly or indirectly to enhance the value or render profitable any of the company's property or rights.
- (k) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of any kind for any lawful purpose with any persons, firms, associations or corporations.

#### ARTICLE III

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

#### ARTICLE IV

The registered office of this corporation in the State of Washington will be located in the City of Spokane, Washington, and the post office address of such office will be Sharp and Rancher Road, Spokane, Washington.

#### ARTICLE V

The capital stock of this corporation shall consist of 5000 shares of common stock, each share being of the par value of \$100.00, making a total authorized capital of \$500,000, and each share shall be equal in all respects to every other share, and each share shall be entitled to one vote.

#### ARTICLE VI

The amount of paid-in capital with which this corporation will begin business is \$500.00.

#### ARTICLE VII

The first directors of this corporation and their respective post office addresses will be as follows:

Each of the directors will hold office until the first meeting of incorporators after the incorporation and until his successor has been elected and is qualified.

#### ARTICLE VIII

The names of the incorporators of this corporation and their respective post office addresses, and the number of shares of stock subscribed by each are as follows:

All shares so subscribed are common stock.

ARTICLE IX

If any stockholder shall desire to dispose of his stock in the corporation or any part thereof, he shall notify the other stockholders by notice in writing of his intention to do so at least 60 days prior to such disposal thereof and said remaining stockholders shall thus have an option for said period of 60 days to purchase said stock offered for sale each in proportion to the shares held by them and for a price equal to the book value of said stock.
