KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the officers, and members of
COUNCIL LODGE No. 85, Independent Order of Odd-Fellows, of Council in
the County of Washington, State of Idaho, desirous of Incorporating un-
der the laws of the State of Idaho, as a benevolent Corporation, acting
under and through, F.E.Brown, William Phipps, and F.T.Mathias the duly
elected acting and qualified, trustees of the said, Council Lodge No.
85, I.O.O.F. of Council, Idaho, and the said F.E.Brown, William Phipps,
and F. T. Mathias , acting in that behalf, to that end do hereby certify :

(First)

That the name of the said Corporation, and the name by which it
shall be known is, COUNCIL LODGE NO.85, INDEPENDENT ORDER OF ODD-FELLOWS.

(Second)

That the purpose for which said Corporation is formed, is to
carry out the benevolent objects of Odd-Fellowship, according to the
usages and customs, and the laws of the Sovereign Grand Lodge, Independ-
ent order of Odd-Fellows, the laws of the Grand Lodge of the State of
Idaho, to own hold and acquire, either by purchase, gift or bequest, real
estate and personal property, for the purpose of carrying into effect, the
benevolent aims and objects, of the said Independent Order of Odd-Fellows
according to the ritual, laws customs and usages of the said order.

To dispose of any such property thus acquired, and to convey the same,
in accordance with the laws of the State of Idaho, and the laws rules
and regulations, of the said order and the by-laws of the said Council
Lodge No.85, Independent Order of Odd-Fellows.

To build, purchase, or acquire by gift, devise, or bequest, any build-
ing for lodge, or other purposes, necessary to carry out the aims and
objects of said lodge, and to borrow money, for the building, or the pur-
chase of any such building, or any such real estate , that may be neces-
sary or shall, be deemed convenient or expedient, to successfully carry
out the benevolent enterprises, and the aims and objects of the Independ-
ent Order

ent Order of Odd-Fellows, according to the ritual, laws customs and usages of the said order.

To mortgage, pledge or hypothecate, any such real or personal property that may be acquired, for any and all of the purposes herein named.

To rent, lease and sublet, any and all, or any portion of any such buildings, houses, lots, or other property, that may be acquired, hereunder.

To take hold and receive any and all kinds of securities, for money due or to become due the said lodge, from any source, and generally to do each act in every transaction, or in the work of the benevolent enterprises of the said Independent Order of Odd-Fellows, that is permitted by the laws, customs, and usages of the said Order, and the laws of the State of Idaho.

(Third)

That the place where the said Corporation shall transact its business, and where its principal business is to be transacted, is at Council, in the County of Washington, State of Idaho.

(Fourth)

That the term for which said Corporation is to exist, is the full period of fifty years.

(Fifth)

That the number of its Trustees, is three, who shall be elected annually, on the last Wednesday of November in each year, and who shall hold their office for the period of one year, and until their successors are elected and qualified, and the names of those elected for the first year is as follows.

F.E.Brown, residence, - Council, Idaho. William Whipple, residence, Council, Idaho. F.T.Mathias, residence Council, Idaho.

(Sixth)

There is no capital stock of the said Corporation.

(Seventh)

That on the 25th day of November 1908, that a meeting was held by said Council Lodge No. 65, I.O.O.F. at the Lodge room in the Town of Council, said State, for the purpose among other things of electing three trustees of said lodge for the ensuing year, and that a majority of the members of said lodge was present and voted at such election, and as a result of the voting at such election, the said F. E. Brown, William

Phipps and F.T.Mathias were elected as such Trustees, of such Lodge for the ensuing year, and until their successors are elected and qualified.
