



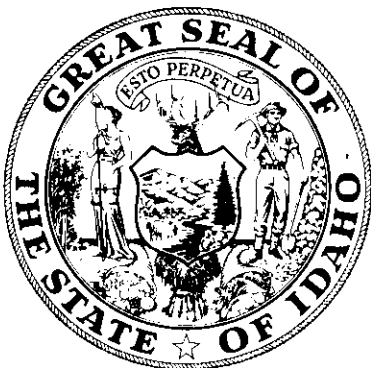

ARTICLE 1

The name of the corporation is SCOTT DAVIS

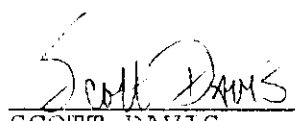
