ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

TETON MANAGEMENT CORPORATION

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We, the undersigned, all being of full age and citizens of the United States, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we hereby certify:

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The name of said corporation shall be Teton Management Corporation.

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II.

I.

The purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

- To act as farm, business, professional and investment management and professional consultants, and in connection therewith to render management, negotiation, research, technical, and advisory services to persons, firms, corporations and others.
- To serve in an advisory, managerial, and consultative capacity to corporations, associations, partnerships, individuals, and others, and to establish and maintain bureaus, departments, and laboratories for industrial, financial, statistical, inventory, and other research work, and to engage generally in the business of providing, promoting and establishing management for agricultural, professional, accounting, business and investment entities.
- 3. To investigate systems, methods, and controls of farming, business, investment, manufacturing, plant operations, packing, storing, shipping, marketing, inventories, accounting, and other operations integral to any and all types of businesses and to make recommendations revise, adapt, modernize, and establish economies to effect industrial and managerial efficiency and in connection therewith to take over the entire operation and business of any type of industry or other forms of endeavor and to do all such things and to perform all such services as may be necessary to carry out the foregoing purposes.
- To devise, develop, create, inaugurate, and contract for the establishment, installation, and sale and rental of systems, methods, and controls for efficient operation and management of agricultural professional, accounting and investment or other business concerns, firms, partnerships, associations, and corporations, and to provide, make available, and furnish maintenance

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and supervision and to train and instruct individuals in the operation, installation, and maintenance of such systems, methods and controls.

- 4. To engage in any and all other businesses of a commercial nature which may be conveniently operated in connection with or incidental to the corporate purposes expressed in the foregoing paragraph.
- 5. To purchase, lease, own, sell, mortgage, sublease, or otherwise acquire or dispose of lands, buildings, easements or property, both real and personal, including all types and kinds of equipment which are requisite for or are capable of being conveniently used in connection with any of the objects of this corporation, and to enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every sort and kind with any person, and to acquire and take over the good will, property, rights, franchises, options and assets of every kind and the liabilities of any person, firm, or corporation, either wholly or in part, and to pay for the same in cash, stocks, or bonds of the corporation or otherwise.
- 6. To purchase or acquire property, businesses, rights or franchises or for any other object in or about its business affairs, to incur debt and to borrow and secure the payment of money in any lawful manner, including the issue and sale or other disposition of bonds, debentures, notes or other evidence of indebtedness, and to acquire by purchase, gift, or otherwise, shares of its own corporate stock and cancel the same or any part thereof, or hold all or any of such stock for resale as treasury stock, or for the purchase of making stock dividends to its shareholders, and to restrict the transferability of its outstanding shares to the extent reasonably necessary to protect the rights of the corporation and its shareholders in any stock purchase, contracts, or options that may be made between themselves or any of them.
- 7. To act as surety or creditor in any and all types of engagements, including the power to execute, endorse and deliver contracts and to guarantee the prompt and faithful performance for payment of debts, notes, agreements, contracts and undertakings of any other person, firm, partnership or corporation, and to act as accommodation co-maker or guarantor on obligations, either as primary or secondary obligor.
- 8. Without in any manner limiting any of the objects, purposes or powers of the corporation, the business or purposes of said corporation shall be from time to time to do any one or more of the acts or things herein set forth.
- 9. The several subdivisions contained in this paragraph of purposes shall be construed as both purposes and powers and the enumeration thereof shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the general powers conferred on business corporation by the laws of the State of Idaho, all of which powers are hereby expressly claimed.

III.

The said corporation shall have perpetual existence.

IV.

The registered office of said corporation in the State of Idaho shall be located in Murtaugh, in the County of Twin Falls, and the post office address of the registered office of said corporation in the State of Idaho is Route #1, Murtaugh, Idaho, 83344. The registered agent is Howard E. Conrad whose address is Route #1, Murtaugh, Idaho, 83344.

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The capital stock of the corporation shall be composed entirely of stock of no par value and the authorized number of such shares of no par value stock shall be One Hundred (100).

VI.
