Order of the Board of County Commissioners of Custer County, Idaho,
Madrigal, Idaho, October 14, 1981.

Present to an adjournment of yesterday noon and at 10 A.M.
Full Board Present.
Whereupon the following proceedings were had:

In the matter of the incorporation of said town of Challis, Custer County, Idaho.

Upon the petition of certain inhabitants of the town of Challis, Custer County Idaho, and after the reading & filing of the petition, herein, and the filing of the affidavit of W.A. Green, declaring that there are now over 100 inhabitants within the proposed corporate limits of said town, and it appearing from that a majority of the taxable inhabitants of said town of Challis, Custer County, Idaho have signed said petition filed hereto, praying that the said town may be incorporated as a village, which petition designated the name, that they wish to assume, and the names and surnames of the proposed village, and it appearing therefrom that a majority of the taxable inhabitants of said proposed village have signed said petition and that there are now inhabitants within the proposed village and the Board being fully advised of the premises.

It is hereby ordered, that the town of Challis, Custer County, Idaho, be and the same is hereby incorporated as a village under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho.

That the incorporated name of said village shall be Challis.

That the streets and bounds of said village are hereby declared to be as follows, to-wit:

West half of the Northeast quarter of Section thirty three and the East half of the North east quarter of Section thirty two in Township fourteen South of Range nineteen East of Range Meridian in Idaho. Constituting the present corporate limits of Challis as appears from the maps on record in the office of the Custer County Recorder at Challis, Idaho and also other records, plans and maps of land located and described as follows, to-wit: beginning at the Northwest corner of Block one to said Township running west one block and thence South one-half mile; thence East one-third mile to the West line of said Township also commencing at the said Northwest corner of block one and thence running thence North and quarter mile, thence East one-half mile, thence South one quarter mile to the North line of said Township all of said territory heretofore described being the proposed village of Challis.

And the following persons are hereby appointed Trustees of said Village of Challis, to serve until their successors are elected and qualified pursuant to law:

- Charles Fiddleton,
- D.J. Frake,
- Thomas Kerr.

In the matter of the application of Mrs. Betty, Administrator for her estate of James Hester, deceased, relative to delinquent taxes on the Silver Lake District Property for the years 1900 and 1901.

It appearing to this Board that said property had been approximately valued for the years 1900 and 1901, it is hereby ordered that the holder of said property be liable for the delinquent taxes of said years 1900 and 1901 upon the payment by the said Administrator to the Auditor of Custer County, Idaho of the full amount of the delinquent taxes of said years 1900 and 1901, and the said Administrator to be found to be due for delinquent taxes on said property, excepting interest for the year 1900, it is hereby further ordered that the Auditor of Custer County, Idaho, receive said property for the year 1900.

ORDINANCE NO. 300

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT ALL BY-LAWS, ORDINANCES, AND RESOLUTIONS OF THE CITY OF CHALLIS, IDAHO, LAWFULLY PASSED AND IN FORCE AT THE TIME THE VILLAGE OF CHALLIS, IDAHO, BECAME A CITY UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF HOUSE BILL NO. 3, AS AMENDED, BY THE 39TH SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT UNTIL ALTERED OR REPEALED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF SUCH CITY; AND THAT THE PASSAGE OF SAID HOUSE BILL NO. 3, AS AMENDED, SHALL NOT IMPAIR OR AFFECT ANY ACT DONE, OFFENSE COMMITTED OR RIGHT ACCRUING, ACCRUED, OR ACQUIRED, OR LIABILITY, PENALTY, FORFEITURE OR PUNISHMENT INCURRED PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF SUCH LEGISLATIVE ACT AND THE SAME MAY BE ENJOYED, ASSESED, ENFORCED, PROSECUTED OR INFLICTED AS FULLY AND TO THE SAME EXTENT AS IF SUCH ACT HAD NOT BEEN PASSED; AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLISHING OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND ESTABLISHING EFFECTIVE DATE, AND DISPENSING WITH THE RULE ON READING.

WHEREAS, House Bill No. 3, as amended, of the 39th Session of the Legislature of the State of Idaho, which took effect the 12th day of April, 1967, provides that all villages theretofore incorporated under the general laws of this State and theretofore operating with a Board of Trustees shall thereafter operate with a Mayor and Council under the provisions of such bill; and

...said House Bill No. 3, amended, the City of Challis has duly reorganized the Board of Trustees of the Village of Challis, Idaho, City Council and has chosen a Mayor of the City of Challis:

NOW, THEREFORE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHALLIS, IDAHO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. All by-laws, ordinances, and resolutions lawfully passed and in force at the time the Village of Challis, Idaho, became a City shall remain in full force and effect until altered or repealed by the Mayor and Council of the said City of Challis.

SECTION 2. The passage of House Bill No. 3, as amended, by the 39th Session of the Legislature of the State of Idaho, which took effect the 12th day of April, 1967, shall not impair or affect any act done, offense committed or right accruing, accrued or acquired or liability, penalty, forfeiture or punishment incurred prior to the effective date of such Legislative Act but the same may be enjoyed, assessed, enforced, prosecuted or inflicted as fully and to the same extent as if such act had not been passed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be published and full force and effect from after the 8th day of August, 1967.

SECTION 4. The reading of this Ordinance on three (3) different days is hereby dispensed with by unanimous vote of the Council.

Passed by the Mayor and Council of the City of Challis, Idaho on this 8th day of August, 1967, at its regular meeting.

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

June 13, 1967

Regular Meeting

Members present: Clyde Rigby, Donald Leuzinger, Willis Buxton and Attorney James Bennetts.

Members absent: William Waetzig

Minutes of the May meeting were read and approved.

Attorney Bennetts reported that Mr. Lloyd Dior would pay \$200.00 toward engineering fees and we would give a two-year credit on the lease between The Middle Fork Lodge and the Village of Challis. He also reported that one-half of the above monies could be applied to the first year of the lease and one-half to the last year of the lease.

It was planned by the Board of Trustees that plans will proceed for oiling Main Street. Attorney Bennetts reported that Wheeler's Sand and Gravel Company had been asked to submit a bid.

The Board of Trustees approved a Government, Department of The Army, survey request for the Challis Airport.

The Board approved the use of fireworks if they are a safe and sane variety.

A motion was made by Clyde Rigby that the City Clerk should attend the Convention of the Association of Idaho Cities in Twin Falls, Idaho, and that the City Municipal Office be closed June 22 and 23. The motion was duly seconded and passed.

Clyde Rigby made a motion that a Resolution as provided by the State of Idaho be accepted which resolution changes Villages to Cities. Donald Leuzinger seconded the motion which passed unanimously, and was ordered published in the Challis Messenger.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS: H. B. 3 was passed by the 39th session of the Idaho Legislature and duly signed by the Governor, and,

WHEREAS: H. B. 3 changed the status of corporate villages to corporate cities, and,

WHEREAS: H. B. 3 provides that all cities shall be governed by a Mayor and Council, and,

WHEREAS: H. B. 3, among other provisions, establishes the powers and responsibilities of the Mayor and Council, and,

WHEREAS: H. B. 3 is in full force and effect;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Challis does hereby resolve to adopt such ordinances as may be necessary to effectuate the provisions of H. B. 3.
