THE UNDERSIGNED, acting as incorporator of a corporation under and pursuant to the provisions of the Idaho Business Corporation Act and the Professional Service Corporation Act of the State of Idaho, as amended from time to time, in order to form a professional service corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

1. Name. The name of the corporation is Daniel S. Bruce, D.D.S., P.A. (the "Corporation").

2. Authorized shares. The aggregate number of shares the Corporation is authorized to issue shall be ten thousand (10,000), all of which shall be common voting stock, at no par value per stock. There shall be only one class of stock authorized.


3. Registered office and agent. The registered office of the Corporation is 5680 W. Farm Market Road, Boise, Idaho 83714, and its registered agent at that address is Daniel S. Bruce.

4. Purpose. The purpose for which the Corporation is organized is to render dental services in Idaho and such other jurisdictions in which the Corporation is qualified or authorized to do so through its officers, employees, and agents who are duly licensed or otherwise authorized to render such services in such jurisdiction, and any other lawful purpose.

5. Incorporator. The name of the incorporator is Angela M. Reed, and the incorporator's address is 601 W. Bannock Street, Boise, Idaho 83702.

6. Cumulative Voting. All shareholders are entitled to cumulate their votes for directors, that is, they are entitled to multiply the number of shares they are entitled to vote by the number of directors for whom they are entitled to vote and cast the resulting votes for a single candidate or distribute the resulting votes among two (2) or more candidates.
