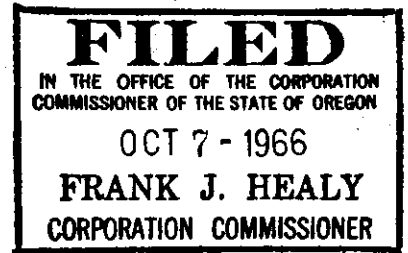

RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
RYKOFF INCORPORATED

The undersigned President and Secretary of RYKOFF INCORPORATED hereby certify that at a special meeting held on September 30, 1966, upon motion duly given and following a resolution adopted by the Board of Directors, the shareholders of said corporation by resolution adopted Restated Articles of Incorporation as follows:

ARTICLE I: The name of this corporation is RYKOFF INCORPORATED and its duration shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE II: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

1. To design, sell, construct and install facilities and equipment for handling of materials of all types;
2. To engage in any lawful activity for which corporations may be organized under ORS Chapter 57.

ARTICLE III: At the time of the adoption of these Restated Articles of Incorporation, the amount of stated capital of this corporation was \$1,020.00.

Article III of these Restated Articles of Incorporation, as adopted by this corporation, now provide as follows:

The capital stock of this corporation shall consist of 1,000 shares of common stock with a par value of \$25.00 per share and all shares shall be of the same class.

ARTICLE IV: The address of the registered office of the corporation within the State of Oregon at the time of adoption of these Restated Articles of Incorporation is 29 N. W. First Street, Gresham, Oregon, and the name of its registered agent at such address is Justin C. Tallman.

ARTICLE V: The internal affairs of the corporation shall be governed by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VI: These restated Articles of Incorporation supersede the heretofore existing Articles of Incorporation and amendments thereto.
