

## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

Know all men by these presents, that we, the undersigned, bona fide residents of the State of Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho.

### Article 1.

The name of this corporation shall be the, "Weiser Publishing Company, Limited."

### Article 2.

The purposes for which this corporation ~~has~~ formed are to purchase, own, operate, maintain, lease and sell that certain newspaper plant now situated in Weiser, Idaho, and consisting of the Daily and Weekly Record Newspapers and all machinery and printing material used therewith, and to purchase, hold and sell any real estate used as a site for carrying on said business and any personal property necessary for the maintenance or the operation of the same, to sell lease or mortgage any of its property at any time, and to do and perform any and all acts necessary for the development, operation, maintenance or closing up of said business.

### Article 3.

The place where the principal business of this corporation is to be transacted is at the Town of Weiser, County of Washington, State of Idaho.

### Article 4.

The term for which this corporation shall exist, is fifty years from the First day of February, 1900.

Article 5.

The number of the directors of this corporation shall be five, and the names and residences of those who are appointed for the first year are, -E.M.Barton, W.W.Pritchett, Gerry Snow, C.M.Nixon and A.G.Butterfield, all of the Town of Weiser, County of Washington, State of Idaho.

Article 6.

The amount of the capital stock of this corporation shall be Fifteen Hundred Dollars, divided into Three hundred Shares of the par value of Five Dollars each.

Article 7.

The amount of the capital stock of this company which has been actually subscribed is Fifteen Hundred Dollars, and the following are the names of the persons by whom the same has been subscribed, to wit:

E.M.Barton, 289 shares, \$1425.00

W.W.Pritchett, 3 shares, \$25.00

Gerry Snow, 2 shares, \$10.00

C.M.Nixon, 4 shares, \$20.00

A.G.Butterfield, 4 shares, \$20.00

Article 8.

The highest amount of indebtedness to which this company shall subject itself shall not exceed *Five Hundred* Dollars.

Article 9.

The manner and time of holding the general annual and special meetings of stockholders, the election of officers, and the methods of conducting the business of the corporation shall be as provided in the by-laws adopted in stockholders' meeting.

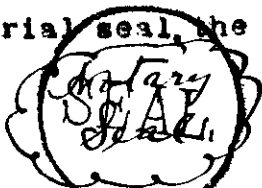
