I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

TREVINO & JOHNSON, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Third** day
of **April** A.D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-one** and
duly recorded on Film No. **114** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho,
and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and
successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for
perpetual existence from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at
Rupert in the County of **Minidoka.**

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
TREVINO AND JOHNSON, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, John Trevino, Helen Trevino, Wendell Johnson and Marie Johnson, being of full age and citizens of the United States of America and actual and bona fide residents of the State of Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

First: That the name of the corporation shall be TREVINO & JOHNSON, INC.

Second: That the purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

(a) To engage in the business of buying, selling, distributing, leasing, servicing, repairing, and otherwise dealing in agricultural implements, vehicles, materials, machinery, and equipment, and in implements, vehicles, materials, machinery and equipment of allied lines.

(b) To purchase, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, lease, sell, exchange real property and personal property.

(c) To own, hold or acquire other stores or merchandise or any and all things necessary in connection with or to beneficial use of the development of the general agricultural machinery business and any and all business used in connection therewith for the beneficial operation of the same.

(d) To purchase land, construct buildings, development of display and exhibition rooms or to purchase, acquire, lease or sub-lease fixtures, merchandise and equipment to be used in connection with said business, and to do any and all things for the best interests of the corporation.

(e) To enter into any kind of contract or agreement co-operative or profit-sharing plan with its officers or employees that the corporation may deem advantageous or expedient or otherwise to reward or pay such persons for their services as the directors may deem fit.

(f) To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, in whole or in part, other business, goodwill, rights, franchises and property for the advantageous operation of the business and to pay for the same in cash or in stock of the company or other stock.

(g) To borrow money and to issue notes, mortgages, and other debentures therefor, and to mortgage, pledge, hypothecate or convey in trust any or all of its property to secure the payment thereof.

(h) To do any and all such other acts, things, business or businesses in any manner connected with or necessary, incidental, convenient or

auxiliary to any of the objects hereinbefore enumerated, or calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the interest of the corporation; and in carrying on its purposes, or for the purpose of attaining or furthering any of its business, to do any and all acts and things, and to exercise any and all other powers, which a co-partner or natural person could do or exercise, and which now or hereafter may be authorized by law.

(i) to create within said corporation, or cause other corporations to be created for the purpose of handling credits, contracts or other items of finance to carry on the finance of said business.

(j) The several clauses contained in this statement of purposes shall be construed as both purposes and powers, and the statements contained in each clause shall be in nowise limited or restricted, by reference to, or inference from, the terms of any other clause, but shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers; and no recitation, expression or declaration of specific or special powers or purposes herein enumerated shall be deemed to be exclusive; but it is hereby expressly declared that all other lawful powers not inconsistent herewith are hereby included.

Third: That the term of this corporation shall be perpetual.

Fourth: That the board of directors shall consist of four (4).

Fifth: That the registered office of the corporation shall be located at Rupert, Minidoka County, State of Idaho.

Sixth: That the capital stock of the corporation is the sum of \$150,000.00, divided into 1500 shares of par value of \$100.00 each.

Seventh: That the capital stock of the corporation that has been actually subscribed is the sum of \$400.00 and that the following are the names, post office address and number of shares subscribed by each:




