ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of the

UNION IRON WORKS.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation and body corporate and politic under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Washington and we hereby certify:

First.

That the name of said Corporation is and shall be known as the Union Iron Works.

Second.

That the purposes for which said corporation is formed are and shall be the manufacture of Iron and Brass Castings of every description and for all purposes and the manufacture of Machinery of all kinds for mines, mills smelters and railroads and the general dealing in machinery and supplies for such operations; to purchase and own real estate, to erect buildings thereon and to equip its property with the necessary machinery to successfully carry out the objects of its business and for these purposes it may issue bonds, notes and evidences of debt and finally to do every thin consistant, proper and requisite to carry out the purposes and objects aforesaid in the fullest and broadest sence.

Third.

That the place where the principal business of said Corporation is to be transacted shall be the City of Spokane, Spokane County, State of Washington.

Fourth.

That the term for which said corporation is to exist is fifty (50) years from and after the date of its incorporation.

Fifth.

That the number of its Trustees shall be three (3) and the names and residences of those who are appointed trustees to manage the affairs of said corporation until to-wit: The second Wednesday in January, 1898 are as follows, to-wit:-

- Harry E. Curtis.....Spokane, Wash.
- H. E. MacCamy.....Spokane, Wash.
- Walter Ogden.....Spokane, Wash.

Sixth.

The amount of the capital stock of the corporation shall be Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) and shall consist of Fifteen hundred (1500) shares of the par value of Ten dollars (\$10) per share.

Seventh.

That the amount of capital stock which has been actually subscribed is fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) and the following are the names of the persons by whom subscribed and their respective amounts.
