Articles of Incorporation

of

Wallace Light & Water Company.

Know all men by these presents, That we the undersigned citizens of the United States and residents of the State of Washington, have this day associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Washington, and hereby certify and declare as follows;

Article I.

The name of this corporation is Wallace Light & Water Company.

Article II.

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be and is Spokane, Spokane County, Washington.

Article III.

This corporation is organized for the purpose of doing any and all business hereinafter provided for in the State of Washington, in the State of Idaho, and in any and all parts of the United States.

Article IV.

The objects and purposes for which this corporation is formed are to locate, own, buy, lease, contract for, improve, work, develop, manage, operate, sell and convey water works, electric light works, water systems, water rights, mills, milling property, real estate, personal property, water power, to supply water and light for any and all purposes, to condemn

any and all property necessary for carrying on the business of this corporation, to borrow money, mortgage and pledge any corporate property as security therefor, to do any and all things necessary which pertain to the carrying out of the objects and purposes aforesaid, and to do any and all business authorized by the laws of the State of Washington, or by the laws of any State where this corporation shall do business.

Article V.

The term for which this corporation shall exist is fifty years from the date hereof.

Article VI.

The capital stock of this corporation shall be one hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars divided into twelve hundred and fifty shares of the par value of one hundred dollars per share.

Article VII.

The number of trustees of this corporation shall be three, and the names of those who shall manage the business thereof as trustees for the first six months of its existence, are E. J. Dyer, Robert E. Strahorn and R. J. Danson.
