

### CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

**HULSE GENEALOGICAL ASS'N, INC.**

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Seventh** day  
of **September,** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-two** and  
is duly recorded on Film No. **120** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State  
of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103 and  
Sections 30-1001 to 30-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and  
successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for  
**perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at

**Ririe**

in the County of

**Jefferson**

and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Cooperative Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

HULSE GENEALOGICAL ASS'N, INC.

1 KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the undersigned, resi-  
2 dents of the State of Idaho have associated, and do hereby associate  
3 themselves together, for the purpose of forming a corporation under  
4 the provisions of Chapter 10 of Title 30 of the Idaho Code as a-  
5 mended.

6 I

7 The business and purpose of such corporation shall be:

8 This corporation shall not engage in any form of trade or  
9 commerce, or carry on any activity which will result in a remunera-  
10 tive profit to the corporation or to its members. Subject to the  
11 foregoing limitations, the object, business or pursuit of this  
12 corporation shall be as follows:

13 To carry on a research to obtain all information available  
14 on the ancestors of Henry Edward Hulse and Mary Jane Weaver, his  
15 wife.

16 In connection with the above mentioned purpose, the object  
17 of this corporation shall be to receive gifts and grants of money  
18 and property of every kind and to administer the same for charitable,  
19 educational, civic and philanthropic uses and to do anything necess-  
20 ary or proper for the accomplishment of these purposes.

21 A further object of this corporation shall be that of pro-  
22 moting aspirit of brotherhood and a closer association between the  
23 members of the organization, and to uphold and maintain the consti-  
24 tution of the United States of America and all the subdivisions  
25 thereunder, and to assist in the maintaining of law and order; to  
26 safeguard and transmit to posterity the purity and righteousness of  
27 individual freedom, and the teaching of our order, as well as to  
28 teach the same to our individual members and to the community at  
29 large; to assist in charitable work of any nature deemed beneficial  
30 and to the best interests of the order and to society as a whole,  
31 and to raise funds for carrying the same into  
32

1 effect in any manner allowed by the constitution and the bylaws of  
2 the order, and permitted under the laws of the State of Idaho and the  
3 Constitution of the United States of America.

4 II

5 The name of said corporation shall be HULSE GENEALOGICAL  
6 ASS'N, INC. and its location shall be in Ririe, Jefferson County,  
7 Idaho.

8 III

9 The term for which this corporation shall exist is perpet-  
10 ually.

11 IV

12 The corporation shall be nonstock and no dividends or pecun-  
13 iary profits shall be declared or paid to the members thereof.

14 V

15 The general officers of the corporation shall be a President,  
16 Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. The number of directors  
17 shall be five.

18 VI

19 The principal duties of the president shall be to preside at  
20 all meetings of the members and the board of directors and to have  
21 a general supervision of the affairs of the corporation.

22 The principal duties of the vice president shall be to dis-  
23 charge the duties of the president in the event of absence or dis-  
24 ability, for any cause whatever, of the latter.

25 The principal duties of the secretary shall be to countersign  
26 all deeds, leases, and conveyances executed by the corporation,  
27 affix the seal of the corporation thereto, and to such other papers  
28 as shall be required or directed to be sealed, and systematically  
29 keep all books, papers, records, and documents belonging to the  
30 corporation, or in any wise pertaining to the business thereof,  
31 except the books and records incidental to the duties of the treasurer.

32 The principal duties of the treasurer shall be to keep and

1 account for all moneys, credits, and property, of any and every  
2 nature, of the corporation, which shall come into his hands, and  
3 keep an accurate account of all moneys received and disbursed, and  
4 proper vouchers for moneys disbursed, and to render such accounts,  
5 statements, and inventories of moneys received and disbursed, and  
6 of money and property on hand, and generally of all matters pertain-  
7 ing to his office, as shall be required by the board of directors.

8         The board of directors may provide for the appointment of  
9 such additional officers as they may deem for the best interests of  
10 the corporation.

11         Whenever the board of directors may so order, any two offices,  
12 the duties of which do not conflict, may be held by one person.

13         The said officers shall perform such additional or different  
14 duties as shall from time to time be imposed or required by the  
15 board of directors, or as may be prescribed from time to time by the  
16 bylaws.

17   VII

18         The officers shall be elected by the directors, who shall first  
19 be elected by the members of said corporation.

20   VIII

21         The method and conditions upon which members shall be accept-  
22 ed and discharged or expelled shall be as follows:

23         Any descendant of Henry Edward Hulse and Mary Jane Weaver  
24 shall be eligible to membership upon paying any dues required by the  
25 board of directors of this corporation.

26   IX

27         These articles may be amended in the manner provided by  
28 statute at the time of amendment.


