KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the undersigned, residents of the State of Idaho have associated, and do hereby associate themselves together, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the provisions of Chapter 10 of Title 30 of the Idaho Code as amended.

The business and purpose of such corporation shall be:

This corporation shall not engage in any form of trade or

commerce, or carry on any activity which will result in a remunerative profit to the corporation or to its members. Subject to the foregoing limitations, the object, business or pursuit of this corporation shall be as follows:

To carry on a research to obtain all information available on the ancestors of Henry Edward Hulse and Mary Jane Weaver, his wife.

In connection with the above mentioned purpose, the object of this corporation shall be to receive gifts and grants of money and property of every kind and to administer the same for charitable, educational, civic and philanthropic uses and to do anything necessary or proper for the accomplishment of these purposes.

A further object of this corporation shall be that of promoting aspirit of brotherhood and a closer association between the members of the organization, and to uphold and maintain the constitution of the United States of America and all the subdivisions thereunder, and to assist in the maintaining of law and order; to safeguard and transmit to posterity the purity and righteousness of individual freedom, and the teaching of our order, as well as to teach the same to our individual members and to the community at large; to assist in charitable work of any nature deemed beneficial and to the best interests of the order and to society as a whole, and to raise funds for carrying the same into

1 effect in any manner allowed by the constitution and the bylaws of 2 the order, and permitted under the laws of the State of Idaho and the 3 Constitution of the United States of America.

The name of said corporation shall be HULSE GENEALOGICAL ASS'N, INC. and its location shall be in Ririe, Jefferson County, Idaho.

The term for which this corporation shall exist is perpetually.

The corporation shall be nonstock and no dividends or pecuniary profits shall be declared or paid to the members thereof.

The general officers of the corporation shall be a President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. The number of directors shall be five.

The principal duties of the president shall be to preside at all meetings of the members and the board of directors and to have a general supervision of the affairs of the corporation.

The principal duties of the vice president shall be to discharge the duties of the president in the event of absence or disability, for any cause whatever, of the latter.

The principal duties of the secretary shall be to countersign all deeds, leases, and conveyances executed by the corporation, affix the seal of the corporation thereto, and to such other papers as shall be required or directed to be sealed, and systematically keep all books, papers, records, and documents belonging to the corporation, or in any wise pertaining to the business thereof, except the books and records incidental to the duties of the treasurer.

The principal duties of the treasurer shall be to keep and

account for all moneys, credits, and property, of any and every
nature, of the corporation, which shall come into his hands, and
keep an accurate account of all moneys received and disbursed, and
proper vouchers for moneys disbursed, and to render such accounts,
statements, and inventories of moneys received and disbursed, and
of money and property on hand, and generally of all matters pertaining to his office, as shall be required by the board of directors.

The board of directors may provide for the appointment of such additional officers as they may deem for the best interests of the corporation.

Whenever the board of directors may so order, any two offices, the duties of which do not conflict, may be held by one person.

The said officers shall perform such additional or different duties as shall from time to time be imposed or required by the board of directors, or as may be prescribed from time to time by the bylaws.

The officers shall be elected by the directors, who shall first be elected by the members of said corporation.

The method and conditions upon which members shall be accepted and discharged or expelled shall be as follows:

Any descendant of Henry Edward Hulse and Mary Jane Weaver shall be eligible to membership upon paying any dues required by the board of directors of this corporation.
