ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SAINT PAUL'S LUTHERAN CHURCH OF CRAIGMONT, IDAHO, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, members of Saint Paul's Lutheran Church of Craigmont, Idaho, all being natural citizens of the United States of America, of legal age, and residents and citizens of the State of Idaho, pursuant to the expressed desires and directions of the membership of said organization, do hereby, under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, and particularly of the provisions of Title Thirty, Chapter Eleven, of the Idaho Code, associate ourselves together and form a corporation, and for that purpose do certify as follows:

1.

That the name of this corporation is:

SAINT PAUL'S LUTHERAN CHURCH OF CRAIGMONT, IDAHO, INC.

11.

That this corporation is created for the accomplishment of religious, social and benevolent purposes, and shall have and exercise in the accomplishment of such purposes, the following particular powers and authority, to wit:

- A. To establish and maintain a place or places and facilities for use as a place of public worship, in the Village of Craigmont, Lewis County, Idaho, and in such other places as its board of Trustees may determine as proper.
- B. To establish and maintain places and facilities for religious instruction, and to further other religious and charitable work, and to provide for the social welfare of its members and the community in which such facilities are situated.
- C. To acquire by purchase, gift or otherwise, and to own, hold, manage, lease, encumber, sell or convey, or hold in trust, real and personal property; to erect such buildings and memorials and other structures as may be necessary

for the fulfillment of the purposes and objects of the corporation; to borrow money and secure the repayment of the same by pledges, mortgages, or the issuance of bonds or debentures, obligating the whole or any part of its property; to receive and accept donations of real or personal property by gift, grant, devise, or bequests.

D. To do any and all other things which may be requested, necessary or proper, in the accomplishment of the purposes and objects for which the corporation is formed.

This corporation shall have perpetual existence and succession by its corporate name.

The location and post office address of the corporation's registered office in the State of Idaho shall be Craigmont, Idaho.

٧.

This corporation shall have no capital stock, and shall not engage in business for profit, but shall be supported by gifts, bequests, contributions, benefits, and dues paid by its members. No part of the receipts or income of the corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of or be distributed to any individual member, members, or officers of the corporation.

VI.

The corporation shall support the doctrine and tenets, and be subject to, the laws, usages and customs of the American Lutheran Church, as may from time to time be established, made and declared by the lawful authority of said church.

VII.

This corporation shall have a bound of trustees, which board shall have the management and control of the real property of the corporation, as well as the control of the promotion, operation and maintenance of the corporation. The Board of Trustees shall be elected and organized in accordance with the customs, laws and usage of American Lutheran Church.

VIII.

Those becoming members of the Saint Paul's Lutheran Church of Craigmont, Idaho, shall thereby be entitled to membership in this corporation.

LX

The officers of the corporation shall consist of a President, Vice-President, and a Secretary, and such other officers as may be provided for by usage and custom, or of the lawful regulations of the American Lutheran Church, from which also shall be determined the term of service and extent of the duties of such officers, and the manner and time of their election.

That the following notice of said meeting, at which the Trustees were elected, was published in the Lewis County Herald, a weekly newspaper, printed and published at Nezperce, Lewis County, Idaho, that newspaper having been published in said county for more than 78 weeks next prior to the date of the election, and said notice appearing therein as follows, to wit:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Board of Trustees and Council of Saint Paul's Lutheran Church of Craigmont, Idaho, will meet on Monday, May 4, 1959, at 8:00 P.M., in the Church Building at Craigmont, Idaho, for the purpose of adopting Articles of Incorporation, By-Laws and such other business as may come before the Organization.

That said notice was published for two weeks as required by law, appearing in the issues of April 23 and April 30, 1959, and a copy of said notice was posted in a conspicuous place on the building where such meeting and election was held, for a period of two weeks, and during the period of publication of said notice, prior to the date of the meeting and election.

That the persons hereinbefore named were duly elected Trustees, as afore-said; that Rev. Donald E. Ausland and Ervin L. Halseth were the presiding chairman and secretary, respectively, of said meeting, and were the officers conducting the said election.
