

Articles of Incorporation

of

The Browne Cigar Store

Know All Men By These Presents, That we, the undersigned, Ralph E. Browne, Frank A. Eveleth and Elvie G. Eveleth, for ourselves, our associates and successors, have associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and by virtue of the statutes and laws of the State of Idaho, and we do certify and declare as follows, viz.:

First--The name of this corporation shall be

"The Browne Cigar Store"

Second--The purposes for which said corporation is formed are as follows:

1. To buy, sell, and generally deal in cigars, tobacco, confectionary, soft drinks and such other merchandise as may be useful or convenient in connection therewith.
2. To lease, buy, sell, use and hold all such property, real or personal, as may be necessary or convenient in connection therewith.
3. To do any and all things set forth in this certificate as objects, purposes, powers or otherwise, to the same extent and as fully as natural persons might do, and in any part of the world.

Third---The amount of Capital Stock of said Corporation shall be Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000).

Fourth--The number of shares composing said Capital Stock shall be One Thousand (1,000) Shares of the par value of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) each, and the amount of capital with which said Corporation will begin business is Seven Thousand Dollars (\$7,000).

Fifth---The principal business office of said Corporation shall be in Buhl, Twin Falls County, State of Idaho.

Sixth---The duration of said Corporation shall be Twenty years.

Seventh--The number of Directors of said Corporation shall be three.

Eighth--The name and residences of the directors of this Corporation, all of whom are citizens of the State of Idaho, who are to serve until the election of their successors, are as follows:
