The undersigned, in order to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the provisions of Title 30, Chapter 3, Idaho Code, submits the following articles of incorporation to the Secretary of State.

The undersigned incorporators are individuals 18 years of age or older and adopt the following articles of incorporation to form a nonprofit corporation (Chapter 317A).

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be iEterna Foundation Inc

ARTICLE II

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is exclusively for historical, genealogical, scientific and cultural purposes as specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The purpose of this corporation is:

- ☐ to enable anyone to preserve their memories, experiences, history, thoughts or creative works for generations to come, indefinitely into the future
- ☐ to provide free access to all submitted materials
- ☐ support research into methods and tools that enable individuals and organizations to preserve their memories, experiences, history, thoughts and creative works
- ☐ support research into archival information storage technology and processes.

ARTICLE III

ARTICLE IV

## ARTICLE VII

The corporation does not have voting members.

## ARTICLE VIII

Upon dissolution the assets, including the data archive, shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding to any section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to the government of the state of Idaho, for a public purpose.

## EXEMPTION REQUIREMENTS


At all times the following shall operate as conditions restricting the operations.

1. No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purpose set forth in the purpose clause hereof.
2. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall constitute the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or any initiative or referendum before the public, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including by publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.
3. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future tax code, or by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future tax code.


