RNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Sandra Gabby,

President, and Camille Lame, Secretary, of the meeting of members hereinafter referred to, of the above-named corporation, respectfully

represent that the above-named corporation was incorporated under the

laws of the State of Idaho on the 22nd day of July, 1935; that on the

28th day of July, 1977, at a regular meeting of the members of North

Idaho Children's Home, Inc., at which meeting a quorum of members of

this corporation were present in person, pursuant to Chapter 11, Title

30, Idaho Code, the Articles of Incorporation of said corporation,

heretofore adopted, published and filed, were amended in the following

particulars:

That the Articles of Incorporation be amended, effective
February 24, 1977, by deleting therefrom, in its entirety, Paragraph
I of Article IV as now written and substituting in lieu thereof the
following:

"I. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the corporation shall not possess or exercise any power or authority, either expressly, by interpretation or by operation of law, that will prevent it at any time from qualifying or continuing to qualify as a corporation described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, nor shall it engage directly or indirectly in any activity that would cause the loss of any such qualification."

That the Articles of Incorporation be further amended, effective February 24, 1977, by deleting therefrom, in its entirety, Article IX as now written and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

"ARTICLE IX: Upon the termination, dissolution or winding up of the corporation in any manner or for any reason, its assets, if any remaining after the payment (or provision

for payment) of all liabilities of the corporation, shall be distributed to, and only to, one or more organizations having either exclusively charitable, religious, scientific, educational or other exempt purposes as described in Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended."

That the remaining Articles of Incorporation, as now on file, in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, including all amendments thereto, shall, except as hereinabove modified and amended, be ratified and approved.
