Keller, all of Lewiston, Idaho, do hereby certify, that we and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, we have associated ourselves together as a corporation for the purpose and under the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth.

FIRST- The name of said corporation and by which it shall be known and designated and under which it shall transact its business shall be The Yellow Boy Mining & Milling Company.

SECOND - The objects for which the said corporation is formed, are: to purchase, hold, operate and work, quartz mining claims and mines, to erect mills for the purpose of extracting precious metals from the ores, both in Idaho, Oregon and Washington and to conduct and carry on a general mining and milling business, and more especially to operate in the Cave Gulch vicinity in Nez Perce County, Idaho; also to buy and sell all real estate necessary or which may be considered convenient for the conducting of the said mining and milling business; to borrow money on bonds, notes or otherwise and for that purpose to mortgage the property of the company and generally to do all things necessary or convenient to carry out the purposes above set forth.

THIRD- The Principal place of business of said corporation shall be in the City of Lewiston, State of Idaho.

FOURTH - The term of the existence of said corporation shall be fifty years from and after the filing of these articles in the office of the Secretary of State.
