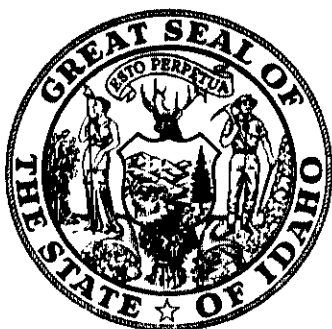

Pursuant to Section 30-1-74 of the Idaho Business Corporation Act, I hereby submit the following Articles of Merger merging NCS, Inc. into Associated Business Products, Inc.

**I.**

NCS, Inc., a Nevada corporation, shall merge with and into Associated Business Products, Inc., a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Idaho. The name of the surviving corporation shall be Associated Business Products, Inc.

**II.**

Alco Standard Corporation, an Ohio corporation, is the parent corporation and owner of all issued and outstanding stock of NCS, Inc. and Associated Business Products, Inc. The presently issued and outstanding stock of NCS, Inc., the merging corporation, shall be converted into no shares or other securities or obligations of Associated Business Products, Inc., the surviving corporation, and shall be cancelled and extinguished as a result of the aforesaid merger.

**III.**

The Articles of Incorporation of Associated Business Products, Inc. shall be the Articles of Incorporation of the corporation surviving the merger. No changes or amendments shall be made to the Articles of Incorporation of Associated Business Products, Inc. because of said merger.

**IV.**

The by-laws of Associated Business Products, Inc. shall be the by-laws of the corporation surviving the merger.

**V.**

The directors and officers of Associated Business Products, Inc. shall be the directors and officers of the corporation surviving the merger and shall serve until their successors are elected.

**VI.**

The merger shall be effective as of the close of business on September 30, 1992.

**VII.**

NCS, Inc. has 1,250 shares of outstanding common stock, no par value. The stockholders of NCS, Inc. voted 100% of the shares in favor of the plan of merger and no shares against the plan of merger.


**VIII.**

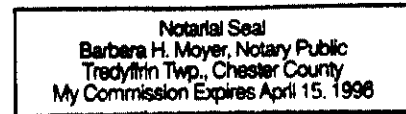
