CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

TREASURE VALLEY CHRISTIAN CHURCH (DISCIPLES OF CHRIST), Caldwell, Idaho

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Fourth** day of **January,** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty,** and is duly recorded on Film No. **110** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Caldwell,** in the County of **Canyon,** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
TREASURE VALLEY CHRISTIAN CHURCH
(DISCIPLES OF CHRIST)

Caldwell, Idaho

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the members of the Treasure Valley Christian Church of Caldwell, Canyon County, Idaho, have voluntarily associated themselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and this is to certify:

I

That the name of this corporation shall be TREASURE VALLEY CHRISTIAN CHURCH (DISCIPLES OF CHRIST), Caldwell, Idaho.

II

That the purpose of this corporation shall be to establish, maintain, conduct and foster a local church of the brotherhood known as the Disciples of Christ, whose local congregations are known as Christian Churches or Churches of Christ. The property of this corporation shall be held in trust for the uses of the faith, teachings, immemorial customs, usages and practices of the religious body known as the Christian Church, officially known as the Disciples of Christ, and for maintaining of a local church of said communion; the foregoing provisions shall not be amended nor deleted from these articles of incorporation of the said corporation.

III

The said corporation may acquire, own, hold, manage and dispose of such parcel or parcels of real estate, together with buildings and improvements as may be deemed necessary or desirable for or in connection with any of the purposes of the corporation, and may own, operate, maintain and manage Treasure Valley Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) and appurtenant buildings and facilities as a place of public worship, religious meetings, education and instruction; and may construct, erect, purchase or

1 otherwise acquire, maintain and operate churches, parsonages and
2 other church buildings and facilities; and may sell or otherwise
3 dispose of or exchange for other property, real or personal, all
4 property acquired by the corporation not longer deemed necessary
5 for its purposes, and may borrow money and incur indebtedness for
6 the purposes of the corporation, and may issue bonds, notes,
7 mortgages or deeds of trust to evidence or secure the same; and may
8 receive, hold, invest, expend and apply for the purposes of the
9 corporation, or any of them, gifts, contributions, pledges, offerings,
10 devises and bequests of money or property; to establish a constitu-
11 tion of by-laws and make all rules and regulations deemed necessary
12 and expedient for the management of the corporation and its affairs
13 in accordance with law, and not inconsistent with these Articles
14 of Incorporation. The foregoing enumeration of powers shall not be
15 deemed or construed to be exclusive of, or a limitation upon, such
16 other and general powers permitted or granted by law, which are
17 in keeping with, or in aid of, the general purposes of the corpora-
18 tion; provided, however, that the corporation shall not hold or
19 own more real estate than may be necessary for the business and
20 objects of the corporation.

21 IV

22 That there shall be a board of trustees consisting of five
23 members, which board shall be charged with the management of
24 the property, both real and personal, of the corporation; and
25 said trustees shall purchase such property, and make such other
26 agreements respecting the same, only as they may be directed to
27 do so by the members of the corporation, and such direction shall
28 be given by a vote at any meeting of the members of the corpora-
29 tion called for such purpose, and by at least a two-thirds majority
30 vote of said members present. The first trustees duly elected are:

Said trustees shall hold office during the term or terms as may be provided for in the Constitution or By-Laws of the said corporation.

VI

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

VII

This corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit and it shall not have or issue any capital stock. Membership in the corporation shall not entitle a person to any interest whatsoever in the assets of the corporation, but only to participate in the management of the affairs of the corporation, in meetings of the members legally called and held within the period covered by the membership.

VIII

The members of this Corporation shall not be subject to assessments for the purpose of paying expenses, conducting business or paying debts of the corporation, or for any other purpose.

IX

That the principal place of business and registered office of this Corporation shall be in the City of Caldwell, County of Canyon, State of Idaho.

X

That in accordance with the provisions of Section 30-1102 Idaho Code, a meeting of the members of said church was held for the purpose of, among other things, electing a board of five trustees for this corporation; that said election was held on Sunday, November 22, 1959, at the Odd Fellows Hall, at Caldwell, Canyon County, Idaho; that notice of said election was duly given

1 in accordance with said section and for the length of time as
2 required therein; that a copy of said notice, attached to
3 proof of the publication thereof in the Caldwell News-Tribune,
4 a newspaper printed and of general circulation in Caldwell,
5 Canyon County, Idaho, is attached hereto and filed with these
6 articles; that a majority of the members of said church who were
7 present at said meeting voted at such election; that H. W.
8 Van Slyke was elected to act as chairman and Mildred McClure was
9 elected to act as secretary at said meeting; and that, at and by
10 such election the persons whose names and addresses are herein-
11 after set forth were duly elected trustees and to comprise the
12 board of said trustees of said corporation until such time as
13 successors are elected or appointed as provided for in the con-
14 stitution or by-laws of said corporation, and further the said
15 trustees were directed, by resolution duly passed, to incorporate
16 said association under the laws of the State of Idaho.
