

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of the

SUNNY SIDE DITCH COMPANY, (LIMITED).

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho;

AND WE HEREBY CERTIFY

FIRST.

That the name of said corporation is the Sunny Side Ditch Company, (Limited).

SECOND.

That the purposes for which it is formed, are: to build, construct and maintain ditches, flumes, reservoirs and laterals for the purpose of diverting water from the Weiser River, in Washington County, State of Idaho, for

milling, mining, manufacturing, agricultural and domestic, purposes, to sell water therefrom by the inch, foot or share, and water rights from it, or any and all its flumes, ditches, reservoirs or laterals, own, control, condemn and sell all real estate necessary for the purpose of carrying on into effect the purposes for which this company is formed, also for the purpose using all the waters run through the same for the purpose of irrigating lands of the individual stock-holders, under the same, or such part thereof as they may need for irrigating and domestic purposes.

That the place where its principal business is to be transacted is Weiser, in Washington County, State of Idaho.

---+++FOURTH.+++---

That the term for which it is to exist is fifty (50) years from and after the date of its incorporation.

That the number of its directors shall be five (5) and the names and residences of those who are appointed for the first year, are-----

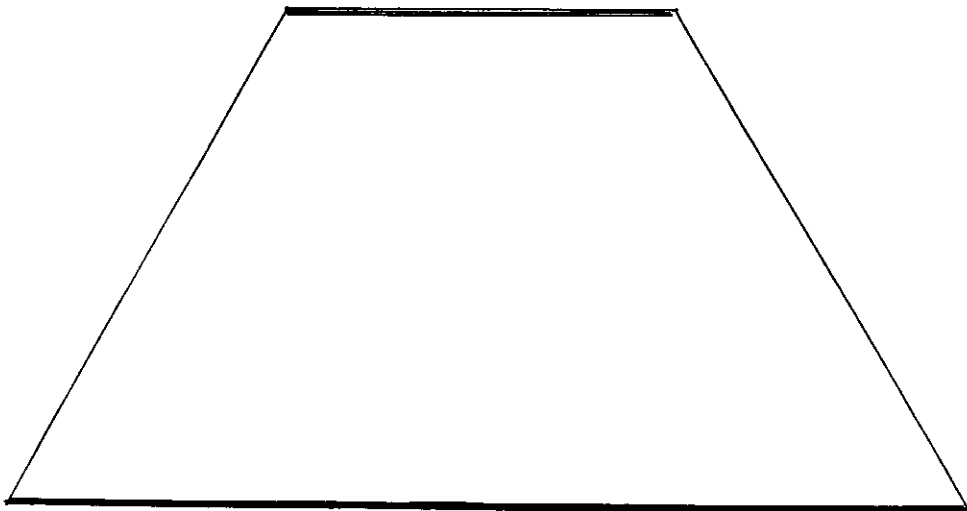
