### CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

#### SOUTHERN IDAHO PIPE & STEEL CO.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **eighteenth** day  
of **May**, A.D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Fifty-Nine**, and  
duly recorded on Film No. **107** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho,  
and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for  
**perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at

**Twin Falls**, in the County of **Twin Falls**.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SOUTHERN IDAHO PIPE & STEEL CO.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all being of full age and citizens of the United States have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we hereby certify:

I.

That the name of said corporation shall be SOUTHERN IDAHO PIPE & STEEL CO.

II.

That the purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

(1) To buy, sell, and deal in all kinds, forms, and combinations of steel, iron, or other metals, and industrial supplies and building materials, or either of any of them, and in the products of steel, iron, or other metals and lumber, or either or any of them, and to transact a general steel, iron, and metal industrial supplies and building materials jobbing, distributing, and mercantile business.

(2) To engage in the general business of custom machine, welding, designing, fabricating and manufacturing work on all things made wholly or partly from metal and to do repairing, welding, brazing, soldering, polishing, moulding, casting, pattern-making, blacksmithing, lacquering, enameling, metal stamping and cutting, and electrical work of all kinds and to engage in the manufacture, production, design, invention and marketing of any and all types of goods, machinery and products that may be conveniently made, produced, used or marketed in connection with the general business of custom machine, welding, designing, fabricating and manufacturing work on all things made wholly or partly from metal.

(3) To manufacture, produce, buy, sell, trade and deal in any and all types and kinds of goods, machinery, products, merchandise and personal property of every class and description at wholesale or retail for and on the account of the corporation or as manufacturer, broker, factor, or agent for others.

(4) To purchase, lease, own, sell, mortgage, sublease, or otherwise acquire or dispose of lands, buildings, easements or property both real and personal including all types and kinds of manufacturing and transportation

equipment which are requisite for or are conveniently capable of being conveniently used in connection with any of the objects of this corporation, and to enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every sort and kind with any person, and to acquire and take over the good will, property, rights, franchises, options and assets of every kind and the liabilities of any person, firm, or corporation, either wholly or in part, and to pay for the same in cash, stocks, or bonds of the corporation or otherwise.

(5) To purchase or acquire property, business rights, or franchises or for any other object in or about its business affairs, to incur debt and to borrow and secure the payment of money in any lawful manner, including the issue and sale or other disposition of bonds, debentures, notes or other evidence of indebtedness, and to acquire by purchase, gift, or otherwise, shares of its own corporate stock and cancel the same or any part thereof, or hold all or any of such stock for resale as treasury stock, or for the purpose of making stock dividends to its shareholders, and to restrict the transferability of its outstanding shares.

(6) To act as surety or creditor in any and all types of engagement including the power to execute, endorse and deliver contracts and to guarantee the prompt and faithful performance for payment of debts, notes, agreements, contracts and undertakings of any other person, firm, partnership or corporation, and to act as accommodation co-maker or guarantor on obligations either as primary or secondary obligor.

(7) Without in any manner limiting any of the objects, purposes or powers of the corporation, the business or purposes of said corporation shall be from time to time to do any one or more or all of the acts or things herein set forth.

(8) The several subdivisions contained in this paragraph of purposes shall be construed as both purposes and powers and the enumeration thereof shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the general powers conferred on business corporations by the laws of the State of Idaho, all of which powers are hereby expressly claimed.

III.

That the duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

IV.

That the registered office of said corporation in the State of Idaho shall be located in Twin Falls, County of Twin Falls, State of Idaho; and that the post office address of the registered office of said corporation in the State of Idaho is Twin Falls, Idaho.

V.


That the amount of capital stock of said corporation shall be Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars, divided into Five

Hundred (500) shares of a par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars each; and that the total authorized number of shares shall be Five Hundred (500) and the aggregate par value shall be Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) Dollars. That all of said stock shall be known as Common Stock and shall be non-assessable.

VI.

That the amount of capital stock of said corporation which has been actually subscribed is Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars; and that the names and post office addresses of the incorporators, and the number of shares subscribed by each are as follows:
