2. To engage in activities characteristic of charitable and benevolent organizations, generally.
3. To acquire and hold, develop, improve, subdivide, lease, construct, exchange, mortgage, sell, convey, finance or otherwise dispose of or deal in, real estate.
4. To borrow or raise money for any of the purposes of the corporation and in connection therewith to grant collateral of other security either alone or jointly with any other person, firm, or corporation, and to make and issue promissory notes, drafts, bonds, debentures, and other evidences of indebtedness; and
5. In general, to do any and all things and to exercise any and all powers which now or hereafter might be lawful of a non-profit corporation to do or exercise, under and in pursuance of the Idaho Non-Profit Corporations Act, or any other law which of or hereafter might be applicable to this corporation.
