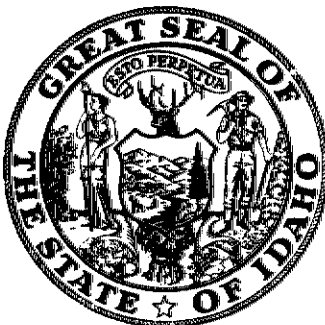

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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the undersigned incorporator, Roy A. Farmer II, desires to form a corporation under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, and for these purposes does hereby make, execute and acknowledge the following Articles of Incorporation:

FIRST: The name of this Corporation is:

B.N.F. TECHNOLOGIES, INC.

SECOND: The period of duration of this Corporation shall be perpetual.

THIRD: The purpose for which this Corporation is organized is for the transaction of any or all lawful business, for which corporations may be incorporated under the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares which this Corporation shall have authority to issue is one hundred thousand (100,000) shares of one class of common stock. Par value of said stock shall be one dollar (\$1.00) per share.


