

WHEREAS, Ada Lodge, No. 3, Independent Order of Odd Fellows of the State of Idaho being one of the lodges mentioned and incorporated under and by virtue of an act of the legislature of the territory of Idaho, approved January 9th, 1866, being in regular session at the town of Boise, in the County of Ada, State of Idaho, on the 22d day of December, 1911, did unanimously pass the following resolution, to-wit:

"RESOLVED, That Ada Lodge, No. 3, Independent Order of Odd Fellows, with its principal place of business at Boise City, Idaho, and organized and existing as a corporation under and by virtue of an act of the legislature of the territory of Idaho, approved January 9th, 1866, that this lodge does hereby accept the provisions of Chapter 14 of Title 4 of the Civil Code of Idaho, and that the trustees of this lodge are hereby authorized and instructed to file such acceptance of this lodge with the Secretary of State of the State of Idaho and the County Recorder of the County of Ada, in proper form, on or before January 1st, 1912, as provided in an act of the legislature of the State of Idaho entitled 'An Act to provide certain grand and subordinate lodges may continue the term of their existence by filing an acceptance of Chapter 14 of Title 4 of the Civil Code, and shall thereupon be deemed incorporated under the provisions of said Chapter, under the terms and provisions thereof' approved March 7th, 1911."

NOW THEREFORE, In pursuance of said resolution of said Ada Lodge, No. 3, we, the undersigned, trustees of said Ada Lodge, No. 3, Independent Order of Odd Fellows, do hereby accept for and on behalf of said Ada Lodge, No. 3, and in its name, all the terms and provisions of Chapter 14 of Title 4 of the Civil Code of the State of Idaho.
