I, J. D. (CY) PRICE, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of **THE FIRST CHRISTIAN CHURCH OF GRANGEVILLE, IDAHO, INC.**

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **twenty-fifth** day of **February** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **forty-nine** and is duly recorded on Film No. **15** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 29-103, 29-1101 and 29-1102, Idaho Code, Annotated.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for perpetual existence from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Grangeville** in the County of **Idaho**, and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 29, Idaho Code, Annotated.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE FIRST
CHRISTIAN CHURCH OF GRANGEVILLE, IDAHO, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, members of the First Christian Church of Grangeville Idaho, being natural citizens of the United States of America and all of legal age and residents of the State of Idaho, in accordance with the expressed desires and directions of the congregation of our church, do hereby, under and by virtue of the law of the State of Idaho, incorporate ourselves and form a corporation as follows, to-wit:

1.

That the name of this corporation is "The First Christian Church of Grangeville, Idaho, Inc."

2.

That this corporation is formed for religious, benevolent and social purposes, and especially, but not in limitation of its general powers:

- A. To provide for the teaching, preaching, and winning of adherents to New Testament Christianity in the local community, the county, the state, the nation and the world, and to seek to achieve this through such organized cooperating agencies and channels as are generally used by conventions of churches known in the Federal census as "Disciples of Christ."
- B. To conduct regular weekly worship services, including Communion, for edification, spiritual growth and fellowship of the members.
- C. To seek to embody as individual members, and as a group, the spirit and purpose of Christ.
- D. To acquire by purchase, or otherwise, own, hold, manage, lease, sell and convey such real and personal property and erect such buildings, memorials, and other structures as may be necessary or incident to the development and carrying out of the purposes herein mentioned; to borrow money for the furtherance of such purposes and to secure the repayment of the same by obligations, pledges, mortgages, or the issuance of bonds or debentures

secured by pledges, deeds or trust, or mortgages of, or upon the whole or any part of its property; to take and receive donations, real or personal property, by gift, grant, devise or bequest.

- B. To do any and all other things whatsoever, which may be requisite, necessary and proper in the accomplishment of the purposes and objects for which this corporation is formed.

3.

The registered address and principle place of business of the corporation is the City of Grangeville, State of Idaho.

4.

This corporation shall have perpetual existence and succession by its corporate name, except as it may be limited by law.

5.

The number of directors of the corporation shall be three, and they shall be elected by the membership in accordance with the constitution and by-laws of the organization. The names and addresses of those who are elected for the year 1949 and until the election and qualification of their successors, are:

This corporation shall have no capital stock and shall not engage in business for profit, but shall be supported by gifts, bequests, contributions, benefits and dues paid by its members. Pecuniary profit is not the object of the corporation and no part of the receipts or income of the corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to any individual member, member or officers of the corporation. Membership in the corporation shall be governed and controlled as provided in the constitution and by-laws of the organization.

Officers of the corporation, as well as directors, shall consist of those provided for by the constitution and by-laws and they shall have the duties and shall be elected for the terms as prescribed therein.

C.

That an election of directors/^{was} held in the City of Grangeville on the 14th day of November, 1948, pursuant to notice thereof, given and a majority of the members of the organization, who were present, voted at such election.

That the following notice of said meeting, at which the directors were elected was published in the Idaho County Free Press, a weekly newspaper printed and published in Grangeville, Idaho County, Idaho, and having a general circulation therein, having been published therein for more than 72 weeks prior thereto, to-wit:

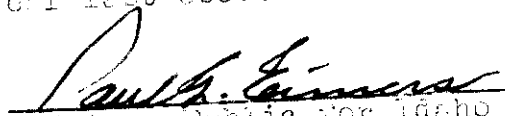
