We, the undersigned, being a majority of the directors of the Cub River Irrigation Company, hereby cartify that a special meeting of the stockholders of said company, for the purpose of considering and acting upon propositions to amend its articles of incorporation, was called by resolution, passed by unanimous vote of said board of directors, at its meeting held on the 1st day of April, 1912; that notice of the time and place of said meeting was published at least onee a week for at least thirty days, immediately prior to the holding of the same, in the Preston Booster, a newspaper published in Preston, Cheida County, State of Idaho, the county where the principal place of business of that said notice contained the text of the proposed amendments said company is located; that a copy of said notice was also mailed to each stockholder tent days prior to the holding of said meeting; that the total amount of the subscribed stock of said com any is fifty-two thousand (\$52,000) Dollars, and that of said stock Forty thousand one hundred ninety-two (\$40,192.co) Dollars was represented at the meeting held pursuant to the above named call; that thirty-five thousand five hundred twenty-two (\$35,522) Dollars of the said stock was voted for, and Pour thousand six hundred seventy (\$4,670) Dollars was voted against the proposition to amend Article Two of the articles of incorporation of said company, as follows, to-wit:

"The object of this corporation is to construct a canal for the purpose of taking the mater from Cub River, in Cheida County, Idaho, to be used for irrigation purposes on adjoining hands, also to construct, acquire, own, hold, operate and maintain canals, ditches, sects, flumes, reservoirs, aqueducts and mater systems; and to appropriate, acquire, bun, hold, aperate and maintain mater and mater rights, to be used in connection with said canals, ditches, sects, flumes, reservoirs, aqueducts and mater systems, for domestic andirrigation purposes and to acquire and appropriate such mater from all available sources of supply, both within and without the State of Idaho, and to purchase, own, sell, and hypothecate the stocks of other corporations, organized for the surpose of supplying stockholders with

water, or for the sale and rental of mater, or for the development and storage of water by the construction of reservoirs, or otherwise, or for either of, or all of said purposes. 2.

That thirty-five thousand five hundred twenty-two \$\\\ 35.522\) Dollars of said stock was voted for, and Four thousand six hundred seventy (\$\\\ 4.670\) Dollars was voted against the proposition to further amend the articles of incorporation of said company by the addition of an articles to be designated as "Article \$X", which reads as follows:

"ARTICLE 5 X "
