ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

APPROPRIATE TECHNOLOGIES INCORPORATED

THE UNDERSIGNED INCORPORATOR, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Montana Business Corporation Act, does hereby adopt the following articles of incorporation:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is APPROPRIATE TECHNOLOGIES INCORPORATED.

ARTICLE TWO

The corporation is to exist perpetually.

ARTICLE THREE

The purposes for which this corporation is organized are as follows:

To conduct generally the business of an ENERGY TECHNOLOGY FIRM providing full and complete services to clients in investigating, planning, engineering, developing, constructing, equipping, and managing installations related to the practical application and use of all and every kind or character of energy source and resource, and including particularly energy derived from geothermal and hydro sources.

To provide a means and method of evaluating, examining, financing, leasing, purchasing, selling, promoting, expediting, developing, testing, producing, and marketing inventions, processes, machines, equipment, and any other product or service of any kind or character related to energy development and production; to employ technicians, experts, and engineers and to initiate, direct and supervise their efforts in research, investigations, surveys, and plans related to the practical application and use of any kind and character of energy

source in connection with any enterprise, project, or matter conducted by or under the supervision of this corporation; and to accumulate data and findings and to compile papers, reports, and books based thereon, practical and theoretical, in connection with development and use of energy sources.

To engage in the business of buying, selling, manufacturing, assembling, fabricating, distributing, leasing, installing, servicing, and managing equipment, machinery, fixtures, and other works of improvement related to energy production and use, either as a principal or as an agent or sales representative for other firms, foreign or domestic.

To act as a general contractor in providing machinery, equipment, and all other materials and supplies related to or associated with the production and use of energy in all forms and from all sources, and furnishing, fabricating, installing, repairing, remodeling, and managing the same, including, but not limited to, the drilling and development of water wells or wells having geothermal energy potential, the construction of reservoirs or other works related to the production of hydro energy and the doing of any and all other business and contracting incidental thereto or connected therewith.

To acquire by purchase, lease, exchange, or otherwise, land and interests in land; to own, hold, improve, develop, and manage the same for purposes of producing, developing, using, selling, or making available to others energy from sources in, under, or upon said lands, and for such other corporate purposes as might be incidental or related thereto; and to sell or dispose of the same, in whole or in part, when desirable.

To negotiate for and obtain loans, grants, or other financing from sources, either public or private, for accomplishing any or all of the purposes hereinabove set forth, either for itself, or as an agent or broker for other persons, firms, or corporations.

To carry on any business whatsoever that this corporation may deem proper or convenient in connection with any of the foregoing purposes or otherwise, or that it may deem calculated, directly or indirectly, to improve the interests of this corporation, either alone or in conjunction with other corporations, firms, or

individuals, and to do all things specified in the Montana Business Corporation Act and to have and to exercise all powers now or hereafter conferred by the laws of the State of Montana upon corporations organized purusuant to the laws under which this corporation is organized, and any and all acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto.

ARTICLE FOUR

The aggregate number of shares which this corporation shall have authority to issue shall be Two Hundred Fifty Thousand (250,000) shares common stock and which shall be all of the same class; each share shall be of the par value of One Dollar (\$1.00).

ARTICLE FIVE

The address of the corporation's initial registered office is 205 West Main Street, P. O. Box 581, White Sulphur Springs, Meagher County, Montana 59645, and the name of its initial registered agent is Michael E. Grove.

ARTICLE SIX

The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors is three (3), and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first annual meeting of shareholders or until their successors are elected and qualify are:

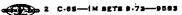

Pursuant to the provisions of the Montana Business
Corporation Act, the undersigned corporation adopts the
following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of
Incorporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is "Appropriate Technologies Incorporated".

SECOND: The following amendments of the Articles of Incorporation were adopted by the shareholders of the corporation on October 3, 1979, in the manner prescribed by the Montana Business Corporation Act:

1. Article Four of the Articles of Incorporation is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

ARTICLE FOUR

The aggregate number of shares which this corporation shall have authority to issue shall be Two Hundred Fifty Thousand (250,000.00) shares common stock and which shall be all of the same class; each share shall be of the par value of ten cents (\$.10).

THIRD: The number of shares of the corporation outstanding at the time of such adoption was three (3) shares; and the number of shares entitled to vote thereon was three (3) shares. No shares were entitled to vote thereon as a class.

FOURTH: The number of shares voted for such amendment was three (3); and the number of shares voted against such amendment was zero (0).

FIFTH: The amendment does not provide for an exchange, reclassification or cancellation of issued shares.

SIXTH: The amendment does effect a change in the amount of stated capital in that the original articles provided for capital of 250,000 shares of \$1.00 par stock for a total statemath authorized capital of \$250,000.00. The amendment reduces the par value of the common stock of the corporation to ten cents (\$.10) per share for 250,000 shares for a total stated authorized capital of \$25,000.00.
