The purposes for which this organization is formed are:

1. To secure and provide lands to be used as burial grounds for the dead.
2. To lay out and plat such grounds into lots, blocks streets and alleys.
3. To provide for the fencing, care and beautification of such grounds.
4. To sell lots and blocks so platted, to make conveyance thereof to the purchasers, and to issue membership certificates to purchasers.
5. To make all needful rules and regulations for the use and protection of such burial grounds, and to provide for the enforcement thereof.
6. To buy, sell, lease, mortgage and otherwise deal in real estate and personal property to such an extent and in such manner as may be necessary and expedient to carry on the business of the corporation.
7. Generally to do and perform all such other acts and things as may be necessary and expedient in conducting the business of providing a burial place for the dead.
