#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

# IDAMO PRIVATE CHILD CARE ASSOCIATION, INC.

In compliance with the requirements of the law of Idaho relating to nonprofit corporations and acts amendatory and supplemental thereto, including particularly Idaho Code Section 30-201, the undersigned natural persons, being of full age and residents of the United States, in order to form a nonprofit corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, do hereby as incorporators, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation and certify:

# ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is IDAHO PRIVATE CHILD CARE
ASSOCIATION, INC. hereinafter called the "Corporation".

#### ARTICLE II

This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. The duration of this Corporation is perpetual. It is organized under the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, Idaho Code 30-301, et seq., now existing or as the same may be hereinafter amended.

#### ARTICLE III

The public purpose for which this Corporation is organized include, but are not limited to, raising the standard of child care for all children in the state of Idaho, providing a minimum

level of uniformity in standards of care for children in Idaho, promoting the adoption of standards and guidelines for acceptable levels of child care in Idaho, assisting in the development of licensing standards for child care centers in Idaho through the perpetration, review and promotion of legislation and regulation, and protecting and promoting the continuation of the private sector's involvement in providing quality child care to the children of the state of Idaho.

# ARTICLE IV

#### POWERS OF THE CORPORATION

The Corporation shall have all the powers provided for in Chapter 3, Title 30, Idaho Code, and as otherwise allowed by law.

# ARTICLE V

#### MEMBERSHIP

There shall be two classes of membership, full and associates.

#### Section 1.

- A. FULL MEMBERSHIP: Owners of each private preschool or child care center or their designees shall be classified as full members and are entitled to all of the rights and privileges of full membership.
- B. ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP: Other interested persons dedicated to the purposes of this organization may be admitted into associate membership of this organization.

  Section 2.

Applications for full or associate APPROVAL: membership shall be made to the chairman in writing on forms provided by the association. The application institutional membership will be reviewed by the membership committee and referred to the board of directors for action. appropriate The application for associate membership shall be reviewed and acted on by the chairman. The applicant shall become a member for the current year upon approval of the application and payment of dues and enrollment fees.

# Section 3.

#### A. RESIGNATION AND REINSTATEMENT:

- (a) Resignation. A member not in default in payment of dues and against whom no complaint or charge is pending, may at any time file a resignation in writing with the chairman. Such resignation shall become effective as of the date filed.
- (b) Reinstatement. Upon written request signed by a former member and filed with the president, the board of directors may, by affirmative vote of a majority of the board members, reinstate such former member to membership upon such terms as the board of directors may deem appropriate.

# ARTICLE VI

#### STOCK

There shall be no stock issued in this corporation.

#### ARTICLE VII

#### DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

In the event of dissolution of this Corporation, the assets of the Corporation shall be distributed to any charitable or educational entity organized as a 501(c) organization as long as no part of the net earnings inures to the benefit of any private individual.

#### ARTICLE VIII

# TRUSTEES

The initial number of trustees composing the initial governing board shall be fifteen (15). The number of trustees can be changed as provided in the By-Laws. Their names and addresses are as follows:
