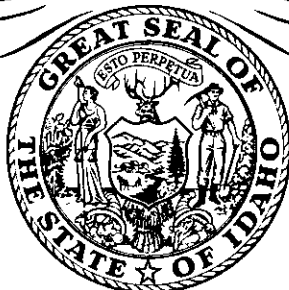

(3) To purchase, take, receive or otherwise acquire, hold, own, pledge, transfer, or otherwise dispose of the shares of this Corporation, but it shall not purchase, either directly or indirectly, its own shares except out of its treasury or, with the affirmative vote of the holders of at least two-thirds of all shares entitled to vote thereon, out of its capital surplus, except as otherwise permitted by Uniform Business Corporation Act of the State of California, by ordinance, or by the Articles of Incorporation.

(4) To do everything necessary, proper, advisable, or convenient to accomplish all of the purposes intended or set forth, or to be added or amended, in this certificate or corrected thereby, which may or may not be in violation of the Uniform Business Corporation Act of the State of California, or of any other Article of Incorporation.

(5) To conduct and carry on its business, wherever it may be, in any part of the world, or in any office, and to exercise all or any of its corporate powers, and to do business in the State of California, in the various states, territories, and possessions of the United States, in the District of Columbia, and in all cities, towns, villages, foreign countries, or countries.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Corporation shall hereunto set forth its hand and seal, and the undersigned officers and directors shall hereunto set their hands and seals, and the seal of the Corporation, at the City of San Francisco, California, this 12th day of December, 1911.
