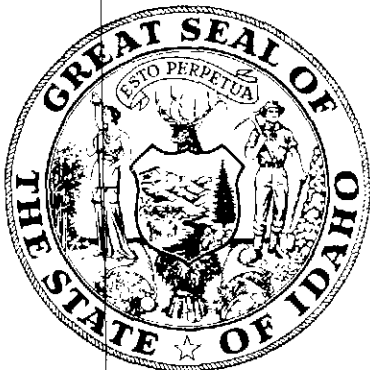

ARTICLE OF AMENDMENT

On March 23, 1980, the shareholders of The Masonry Center, Inc., adopted by written unanimous consent pursuant to Section 30-1-145, Idaho Code, an amendment to the Articles of Incorporation, which amendment provides in full:

ARTICLE XV First Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of The Masonry Center, Inc.

Section 1. The shareholders and members of the Board of Directors are engaged in other business ventures and are not required to devote all of their business time to the affairs of The Masonry Center, Inc., but shall devote as much time as each individually shall deem necessary for the proper and efficient conduct of the business of The Masonry Center, Inc. The shareholders and members of the Board of Directors have no obligation to offer to The Masonry Center, Inc., any business opportunities, regardless whether the business opportunity is germane to the business of The Masonry Center, Inc., or whether knowledge of the business opportunity was acquired while conducting the business of The Masonry Center, Inc.

Section 2. This amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of The Masonry Center, Inc., shall be adopted by unanimous vote of the outstanding shares of the corporation.


At the time of the adoption of this amendment Article XV, 10,000 shares of The Masonry Center, Inc., were issued and entitled to vote on the proposed amendment. The amendment Article XV was adopted by unanimous consent of all shareholders, no shareholder dissenting.


