ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

WESTERN CARTOGRAPHY, INC.

We, the undersigned, do by these presents, pursuant to and in conformity with the laws of the State of Montana, hereby agree to and do organize and associate ourselves together to form a corporation, claiming all the benefits, rights and privileges granted by the laws of said State of Montana, and we do hereby agree upon, enact and adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of said corporation is:

" WESTERN CARTOGRAPHY. INC."

ARTICLE II

The objects and purposes for which said corporation is formed are as follows:

- (a) To carry on the business of stationers, printers, cartographers, lithographers, stereotypers, electrotypers, photographic printers, photo-lithographers, photo-cartographers, engravers, die-sinkers, book printers, account book manufacturers, dealers in parchment, dealers in maps, designers, draftsmen, ink manufacturers book sellers, publishers, paper manufacturers and dealers in the materials used in the manufacture of paper, and dealers in or manufacturers of any other articles or things of a character similar or analogous to the foregoing, or any of them, or connected therewith.
- (b) To acquire buildings, machinery, tools, equipment, types, fixtures and materials of various kinds suitable for the printing, drafting and compilation of pamphlets, maps and papers of every description and to do any and all acts and transact any and all business that shall be or become incident to, or arise out of, or be connected with such business or any part thereof.
- (c) To conduct said business above mentioned in all its branches and ramifications and have and maintain one or more offices for the transaction

of business; to hold without limit, to purchase and convey real and personal property both within and without the State of Montana.

(d) To purchase, lease, contract for or otherwise acquire real estate, buildings and structures, real property and all estates, rights and interests therein of every kind, nature and description, and wheresoever situated, both within and without the State of Montana; and to own, hold, use, occupy, develop, improve, sell, lend, lease or otherwise deal with or dispose of any or all of such real estate, buildings and structures for every legal purpose to which the same may be put.

- (e) To purchase, lease, contract for or otherwise acquire personal property and all estates, rights and interests therein of every kind, nature and description, and to own, hold, use, occupy, develop, improve, sell, lend, lease or otherwise deal with or dispose of any or all of such personal property for every legal purpose to which the same may be put.
- (f) To secure, acquire and turn to account any license, patent, trademark, concession, or any property rights or privileges of a light character and to carry on any business which said corporation may deem proper directly or indirectly to effectuate and accomplish any of the ends or purposes of the corporation.
- (g) To purchase, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, pledge, sell, assign, transfer, or otherwise deal in or dispose of its own capital stock and shares of the capital stock, bonds, securities, or other evidences of indebtedness of other corporations, with all the rights, powers and privileges incident to ownership thereof.
- (h) To lend, and borrow money, and to sell, convey, transfer, rent, lease, pledge, mortgage, encomber, hypothecate or otherwise deal in or dispose of any of the property belonging to this Corporation, both real and personal, including shares of capital stock and securities, and to make, execute, deliver and receive all commercial paper, contracts, agreements, promissory notes, mortgages and all such other instruments as may be required in connection therewith.
- (i) To do each and everything necessary, suitable, useful or advisable for the accomplishment of anyone or more of the of the objects and purposes of the Corporation hereinabove or hereinafter set forth, or which shall at any time appear to be conducive to or expedient for the benefit of the Corporation.
- (j) To have and exercise all of the powers conferred by the laws of the State of Montana upon private business corporations, and to do each and everything necessary or proper for the accomplishment of any purpose or the attainment of any one

or more of the objects and purposes herein enumerated.

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It is intended that each of the clauses contained in Article II hereof shall be in no way limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clause or any other paragraph contained in this instrument, but that the objects, purposes and powers specified in each of the clauses of this Article II shall be regarded as independent objects, purposes and powers.

ARTICLE III

The principal place of business of this Corporation and its principal office shall be at the City of Missoula, in the County of Missoula, State of Montana. The Board of Directors may from time to time establish and maintain such other places of business and such other offices as may be useful or convenient in transacting the business affairs of the Corporation

ARTICLE IV

The term for which this Corporation shall exist is forty (40) years.

ARTICLE V

The affairs of this Corporation shall be managed, conducted and carried on by a Board of Directors. 

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF WESTERN CARTOGRAPHY, INC.



Pursuant to the provisions of Section 15-225, R.C.M., 1947, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation:

- (a) The name of the corporation is WESTERN CARTOGRAPHY, INC.
- (b) The following amendments of the Articles of
 Incorporation were adopted by the shareholders of the Corporation
 on June 13, 1975, in the manner prescribed by the Montana
 Business Corporation Act.
- RESOLVED: That the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation be, and they hereby are amended by changing the name of the corporation from WESTERN CARTOGRAPHY, INC. to PROFESSIONAL CONSULTANTS, INCORPORATED, and that paragraph (a) of Article II be amended to read as follows: To carry on the business of surveying, geology, cartography, lithography, mapping, planning, designing, drafting, and engineering (under supervision of licensed engineer), or business and activities of a character similar or analogous to the foregoing, or any of them, or connected therewith or related thereto." Further that Article V be amended so as to change the number of Directors of the Corporation from three (3) to five (5); that Article VI change the authorized capitalization of the Corporation from \$50,000 to \$100,000 and 500 shares to 1,000 shares; and that a new numbered article as number IX be added to the Articles of Incorporation which would read as follows: "The corporation shall have the first option for thirty (30) days to purchase the shares of any stockholder who wishes to sell all or part

of his stock in the corporation. The Company shall pay for the stock a price to be determined by an appraisal thereof in such manner as specified by the Board of Directors of the Corporation. If the Corporation does not exercise the option, the offering stockholder shall be free to sell said stock in the manner and under the conditions described in the By-Laws. In no event shall the shares of stock in this Corporation be transferred or sold unless the proposed sale or transfer shall have been reported to the Board of Directors and approved by them." Resolved also, that Article II of the By-Laws be amended by providing therein for a stock option plan.

(d) The number of shares of corporate stock outstanding at the time of such adoption was 159 and the number of shares entitled to vote thereon was 159.


