ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
CASCADE SENIOR CITIZENS, INC.

26 JUL 1 1991

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, the President and Secretary respectively of CASCADE SENIOR CITIZENS, INC., an Idaho corporation, do hereby certify as follows:

That CASCADE SENIOR CITIZENS, INC. is a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho;

That at a special meeting held in Cascade, Idaho, in accordance with the provisions of Section 30-146, 30-147 and 30-148, of Idaho Code, that the following is a resolution which was regularly proposed, voted upon, and adopted by the unanimous vote of all of said membership present, amending the articles of incorporation of said corporation; that the following is a full, true and correct copy of the resolution of said membership amending the articles of incorporation, towit;

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED, that articles of incorporation of CASCADE SENIOR CITIZENS, INC. be and they hereby are amended as follows:

ARTICLE IX

The registered office of this Corporation shall be Cascade Senior Citizens Center, P.O. Box 1022, Cascade, Idaho 83611.

ARTICLE XV

This corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE XVI

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE XVII


Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the organization, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or corporation which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
